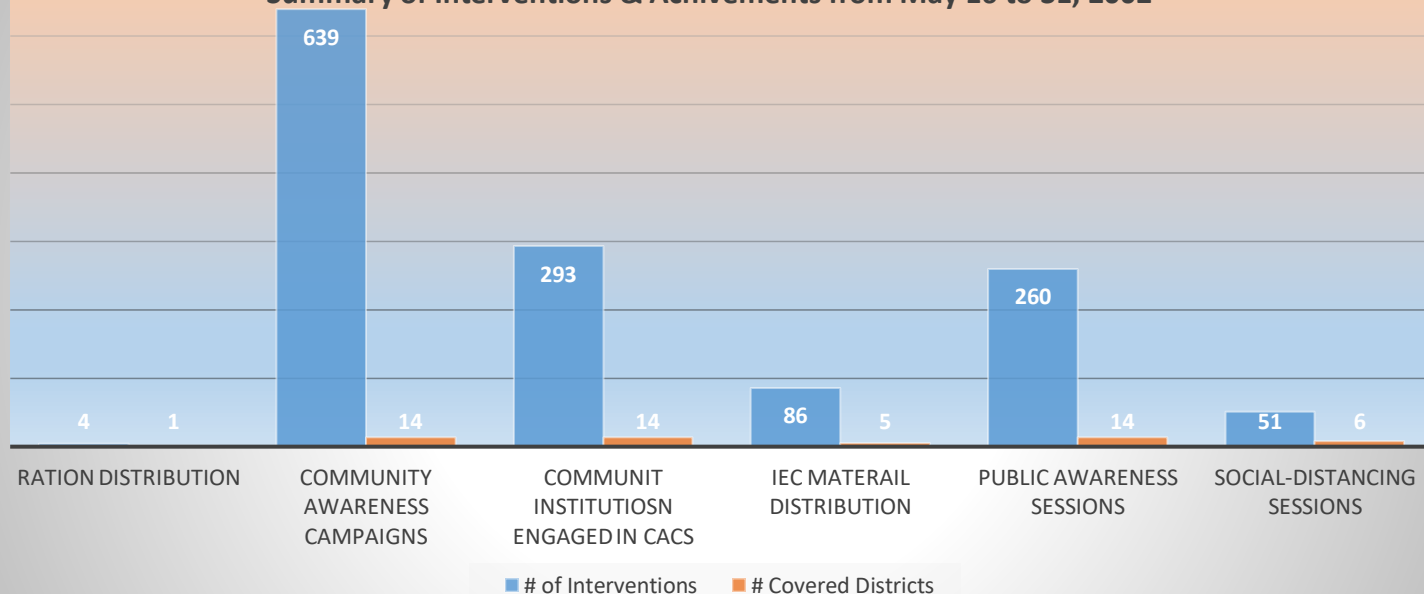
## 1. INTERVENTIONS & ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE REPORTING PERIOD-MAY-16 to 31, 2020.

- **04, Poor households (HHs)** were provided **Ration Bags** by utilizing community savings.
- **629, Community Awareness Campaigns** on COVID -19 were conducted in the SRSO outreach districts.
- **293, Community Institutions** (LSOs, VOs, COs) were engaged to undertake COVID-19 awareness campaigns in all 14 districts.
- **86, posters, pamphlets** were distributed/displayed at prominent places at the community level in 5 districts.
- **260, Public Awareness Sessions** on COVID-19 were undertaken with communities in all 14 districts.
- **51, Sessions on Social Distancing** aiming at behavioral changes were conducted in 8 districts.
- **06, MoUs** were signed with District Administrations under NCOC agreement regarding community mobilization and awareness-raising on COVID-19.

## 2. OVERALL INTERVENTIONS & ACHIEVEMENTS IN COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE TILL MAY 31, 2020



### A. RATION/FOOD DISTRIBUTION

- **1,072, poor households were provided Cash Grant. 995 households were facilitated from community saving while 77, through Government support.**
- **16,079, poor households were provided Ration Bags in which 4,718 through community saving, 1,538 through Local philanthropists and 9,823 through Government.**

### B. COMMUNITY AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS

- **28,043, Community awareness campaigns were carried out where 1,820 community volunteers (community leaders, CRPs, etc.) were participated.**
- **13,006, Community Institutions (LSOs, VOs, COs) engaged to undertake COVID-19 awareness campaigns.**
- **7,213, IEC material were distributed/displayed among the targeted communities.**
- **1,733 announcements were made using mobile speakers & 386 Number of announcements made using local mosques/ churches/ mandirs for community awareness raising on COVID-19.**
- **3,499, sessions were undertaken with communities regarding to COVID-19 awareness raising.**

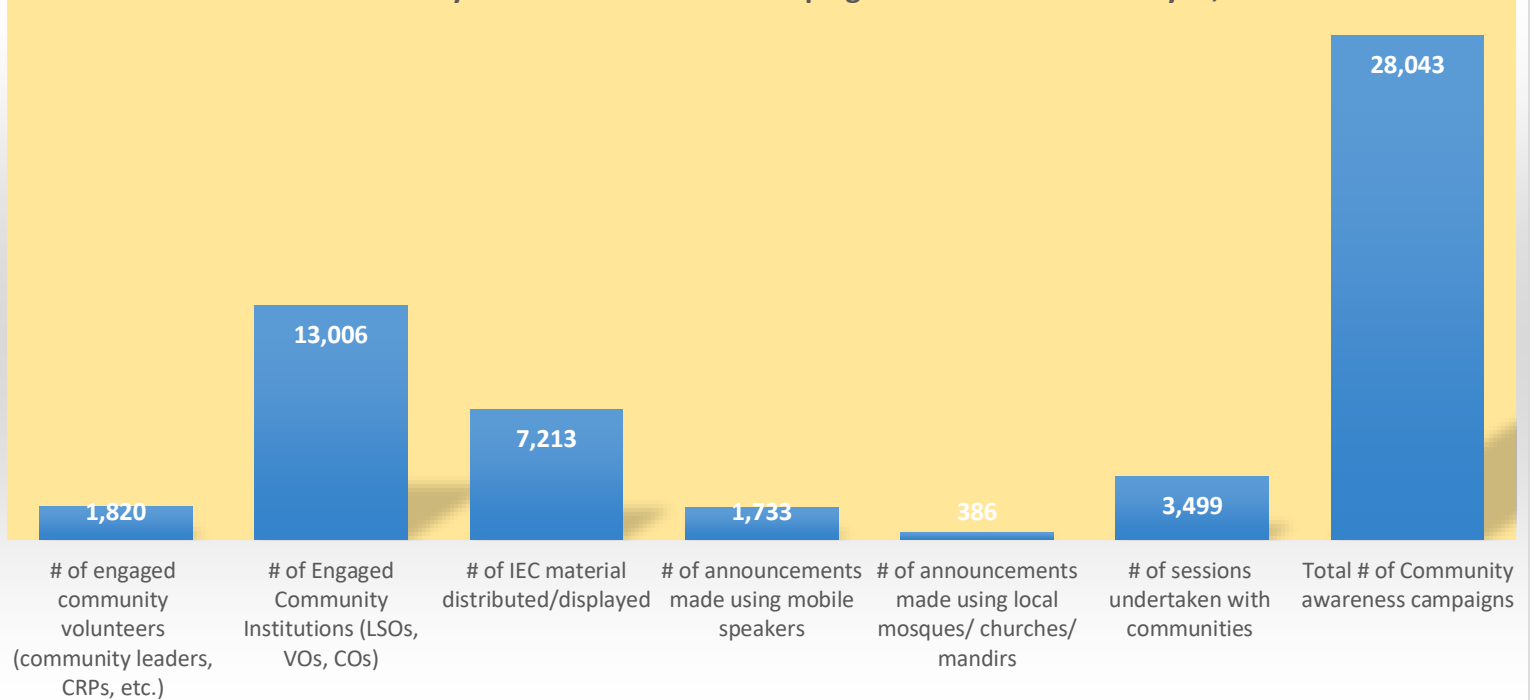

- **660, sessions were conducted on Social- Distancing** aiming at behavioral changes in which **8,030 community members** have participated.





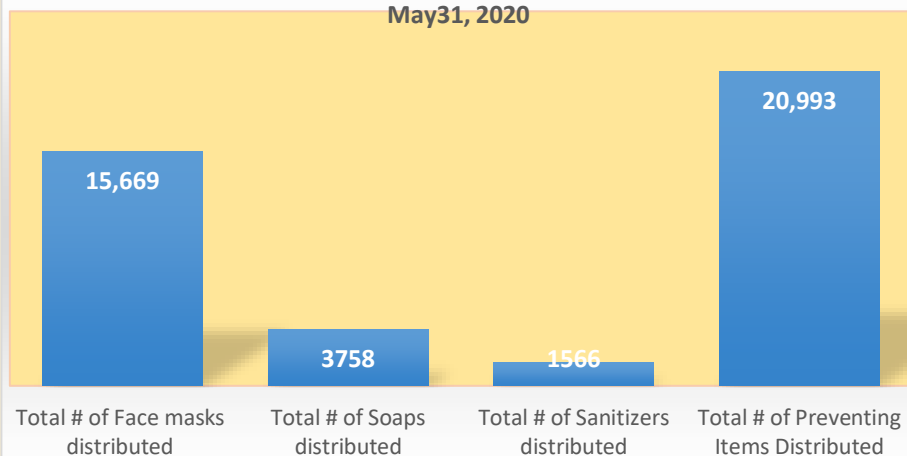

## D.PRE-CAUTIONARY ITEMS DISTRIBUTION

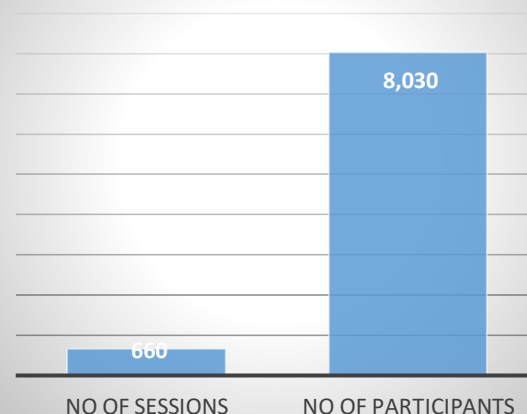
- **15,669, face Masks** were distributed among the communities in operational areas of SRSO by BDGs and VO's members.

## E.REGISTRATION UNDER EHSAAS CASH PROGRAMME

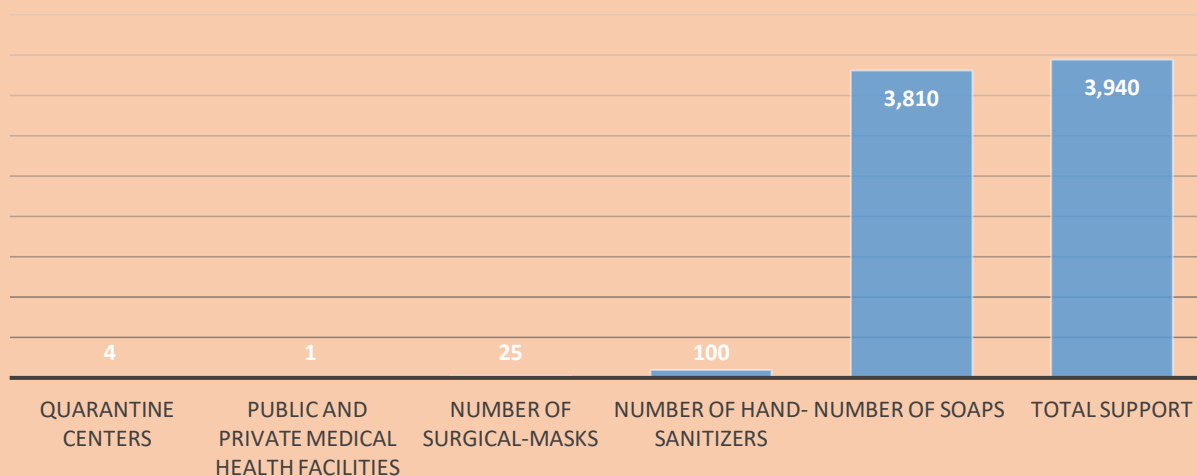
- **194,824**, beneficiaries were registered under EHSAAS emergency Cash Programme in SRSO operational areas.



## F. Support to Government Health Facilities

- **4**, quarantine centers set-up by local authorities and private entities supported by provision of cooked food, surgical-masks, sanitizers and soap.
- **01**, public and private medical health facilities supported by provision of medicines, surgical-masks, sanitizers and soap;
- **25**, surgical-masks provided to these public and private centers.
- **100**, hand-sanitizers provided to these public and private centers.
- **3,810**, soaps provided to these public and private centers.

## 3. DETAILS OF EMERGENCY RESPONSE

### 3.1 Ration Distribution among Poor HHs to Combat with COVID-19 Emergency

#### Key Interventions & Achievements:

The Local Support Organization (LSO) Joat, UC Jumo Agham, District Larkana, has taken another initiative to provide basic facilities to poor households of the community. Through contact with representatives of local Government, LSO has received ration for 200 households and distributed among the most poor families of the area on May 18, 2020.

Friends from Mithi (without showing their names) distributed ration among 160 poor daily wage earners at Hindu families of village Narain Water, jam colony, Porho Bheel, Ragho Bheel, Banhoon Bheel, Mahadev Solanki, Bhawlo Kolhi, Kirshan Thakur, Ahmed Abad and Qaim Khan Laghari in Union Councils Malkani Sharif and Khairpur Ghamboh of Taluka Tando Bago District Badin on May 18, 2020. The total amount PKR 200,000 and each ration bag is amount PKR 1,250 were distributed in these vulnerable families of 2 UCs

LSO Roshan Deeo, Union council Abri, Taluka Kamber, district Kamber Shahdadkot, contacted with different philanthropists for Ration distribution in their VO's, after these efforts LSO received ration for 200 households. LSO also facilitated their community for registration in Ehsas programme, they prepared a list of 180 poor households and Submitted at assistant commissioner office Kamber, from which 95 nominated households received cash.



Sindh Rural Support Organization team Ghotki organized distribution ceremony on May 31, 2020, for the Donor Mr. Usman Abdullah (ADC-Ghotki) and his mother and they distributed Goats amongst CO members/needy beneficiaries and among 41 lists 17 beneficiaries have provided goats in 1st phase. Distribution location was kept according to the nearest point for all four taluka beneficiaries and they gathered at Public Park Mirpur Mathelo district Ghotki and received 1 Goat each beneficiary and PKR-1000/= transport cost.



The Local Support Organisation (LSO) Chand Union Council Kaak, Taluka Shujaabad, District Mirpurkhas distributed ration with the support of Kadela group limited among 700 poor daily wage earners families on May 18, 2020, whose have suffered a lot due to COVID 19 emergency. SRSO Team ensured all SoPs were followed properly during distribution.

- **86, IEC material /items** were distributed/displayed in communities for community awareness-raising in 5 districts.

The hand-washing activity is the part and partial of community based awareness sessions and it has been conducted on regular basis during each activity by SRSO Team and community institutions. There is selected pictorial highlights of the conducted hand washing activity during this reporting period



- **260, Public Awareness Sessions** on COVID-19 were undertaken with communities in all 14 districts

- 51, Sessions on Social Distancing aiming at behavioral changes were conducted in 8 districts.

- **180, face masks** were distributed/handed over district administration of District Shikarpur by SRSO District Manager Shikarpur.
- **4, district administrations** of Kshmore@ Kandhkot, Umerkort, Larkana, and Shikarpur have issued appreciation letters to Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) and District Teams on continuously supporting to the district administration and as well as community institutions to combating with COVID-19 Emergency in the districts.
- **Regional Manager-SRSO** along with DM –District Mirpurkhas conducted a meeting on May 29, 2020, with Mr. Zahid Memon DC MPK for MoU under NCOC agreement and Mr.Jhaman Heerani AC-General Administration for sharing PPRP-Community Institutions (CIs) working in COVID-19 Emergency as well in future for utilizing the CIs network.





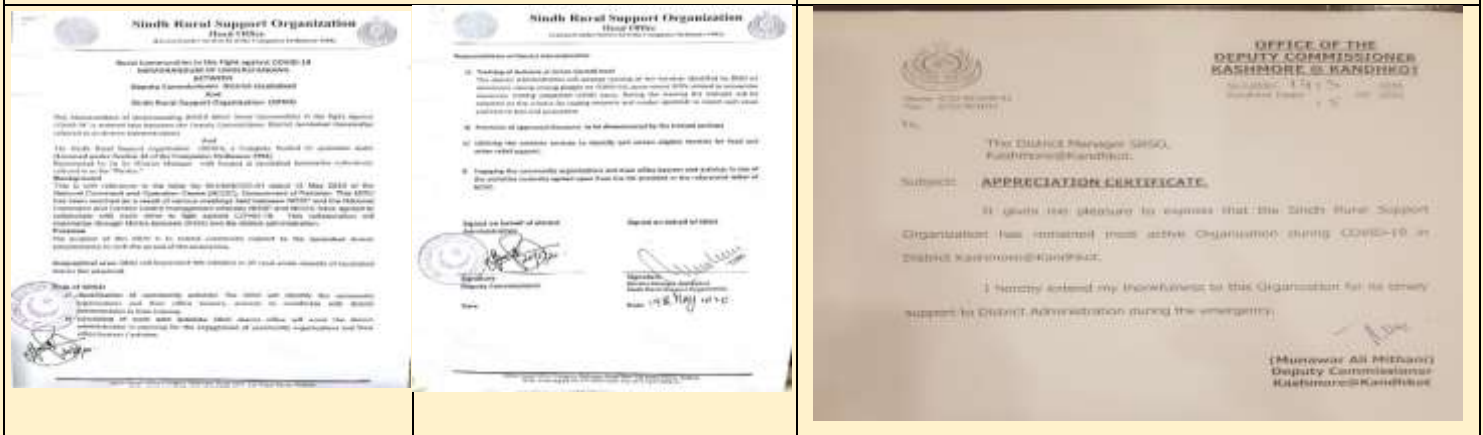

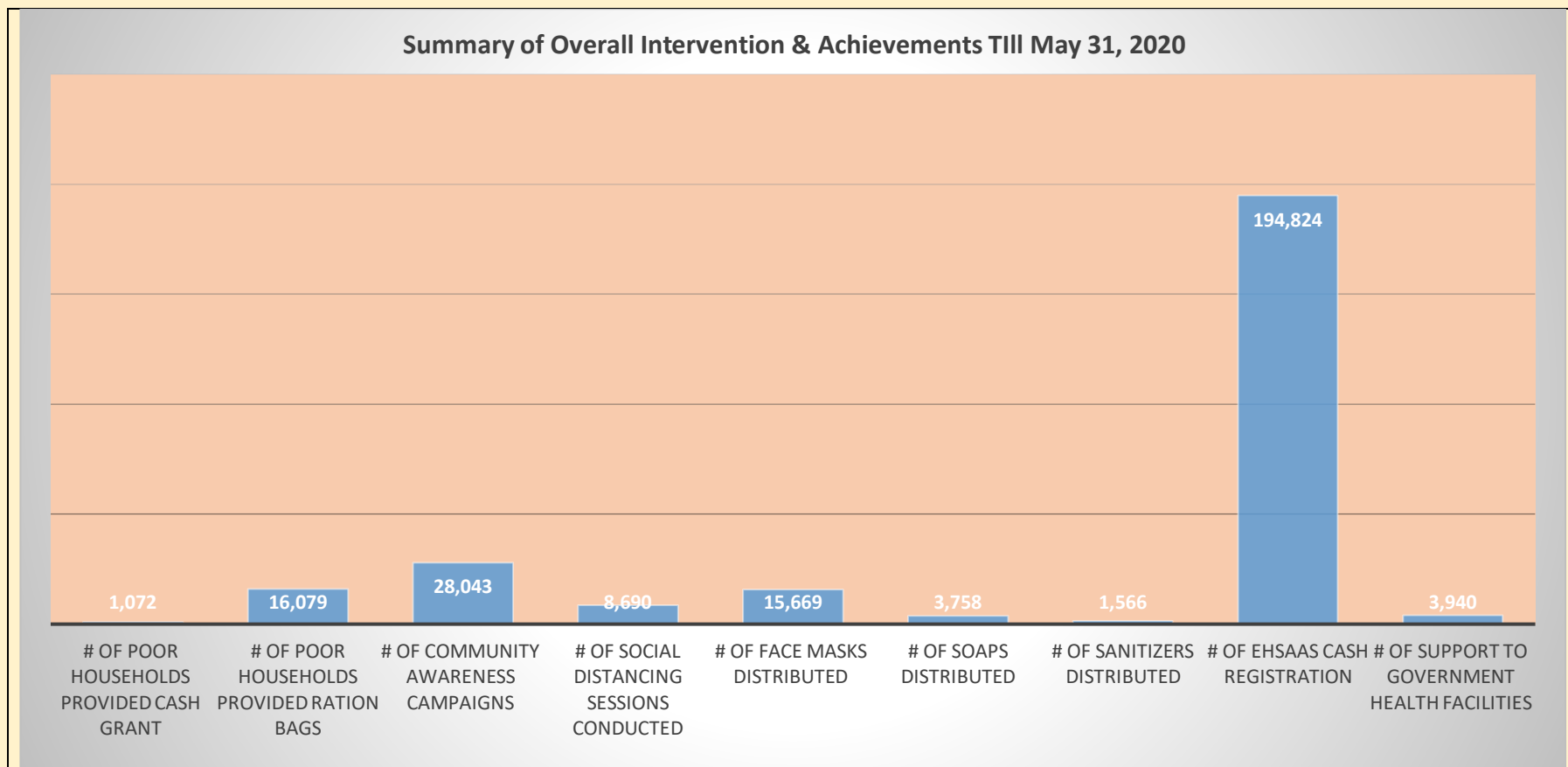
