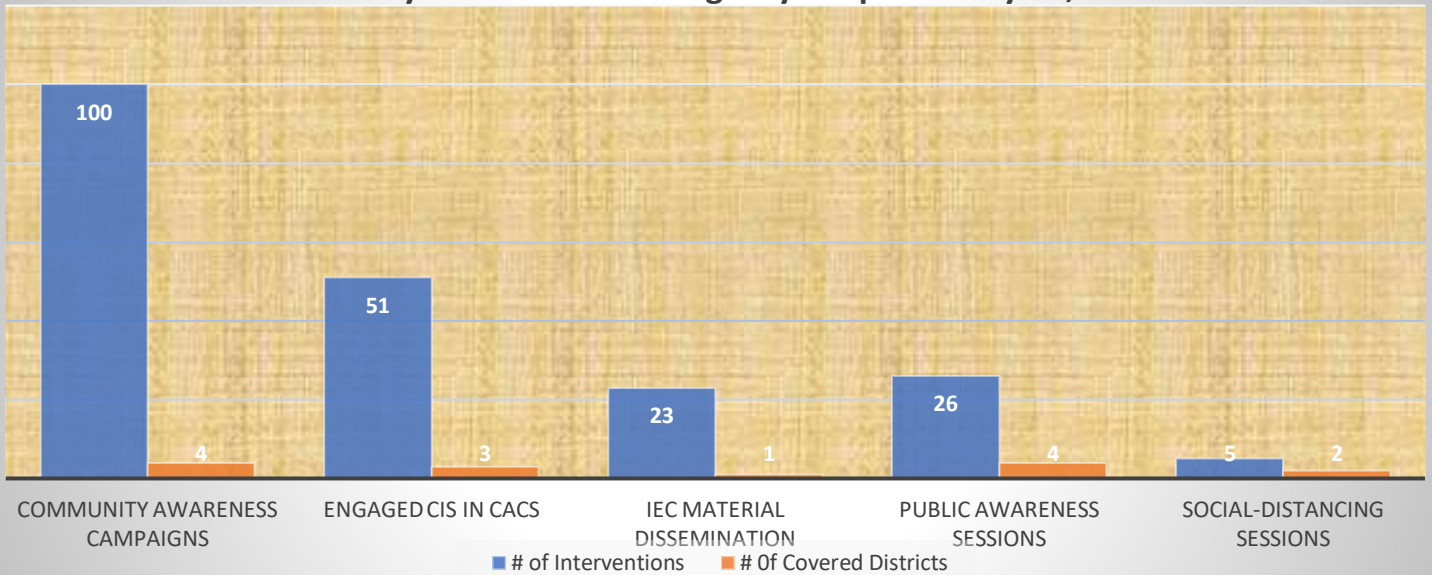

Highlights of the Day Interventions-July 20, 2020:

- **51, Community Institutions** (LSOs, VOs, COs) were engaged to undertake COVID-19 awareness campaigns. Khairpur 3, Jacobabd 42, and Shikarpur 6.
- **23, IEC material /items** were distributed/displayed in SRSO out-reach districts under signed MoU with district administration regarding to NCOC agreement at District Jacobabad.
- **26, Public Awareness Sessions** on COVID-19 were undertaken with communities. Khairpur 1, Mirpurkhas 1, Jacobabad 18, and Shikarpur 6.
- **05, Sessions on Social Distancing** aiming at behavioral changes were conducted in District Khairpuyr 2 and Mirpurkhas 3, and and participated by **105 Community Members**.
