OVERALL KEY INTERVENTIONS & ACHIVEMENTS TILL JUNE 15, 2020.

A. RATION DISTRIBUTION

17, 163 , poor households were **distribution ration** in which provided **Cash Grant 1,072** and **Ration Bags 16,091** through community savings, local philanthropists and Govt. support.

B. COMMUNITY AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS

29, 161, community awareness campaigns were conducted on COVID -19 through **1,820 community volunteers** (community leaders, CRPs, etc.) and **13, 477 community institutions** (COs, VO and LSOs) engaged on public awareness campaigns.

C. THE SOCIAL-DISTANCING

7, 67, social-Distancing sessions aiming at behavioral changes were conducted at community level in which **9,469 community members** have participated and made aware.

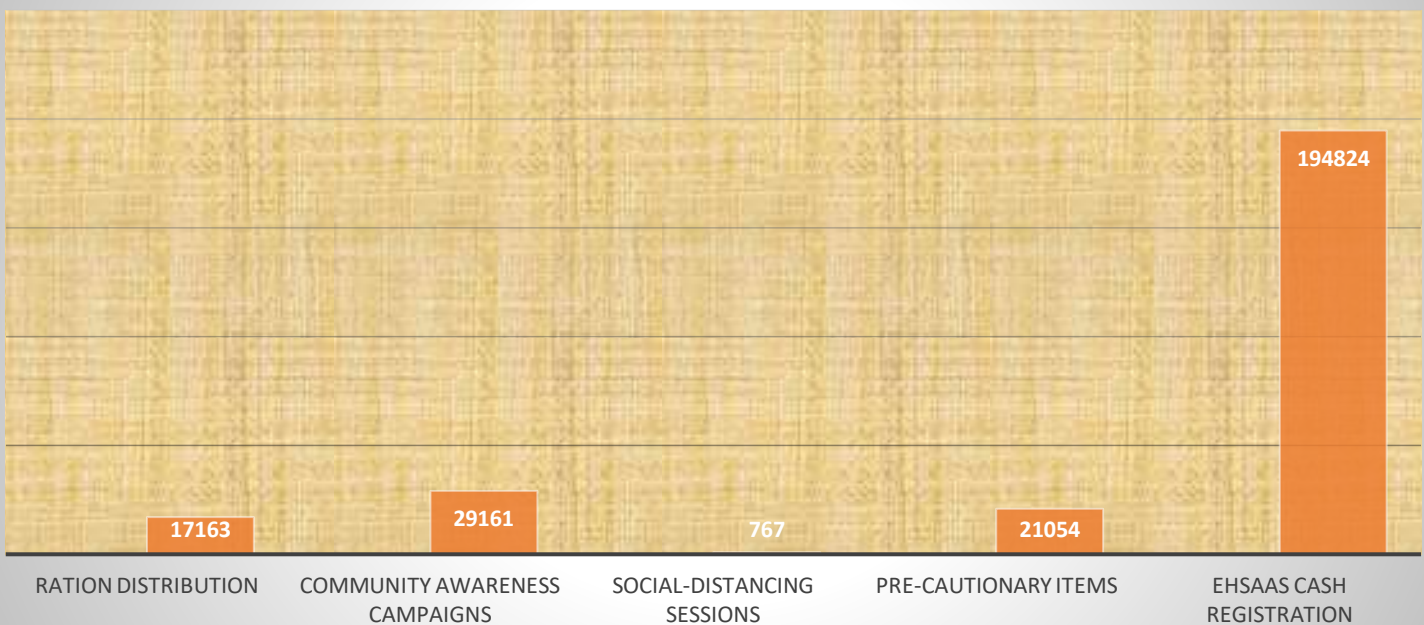
D. PRE-CAUTIONARY ITEMS DISTRIBUTION

21,054, pre-cautionary Items were distributed among the communities in which including 15,708 face masks, 3,770 soaps, and 1,576 sanitizers.

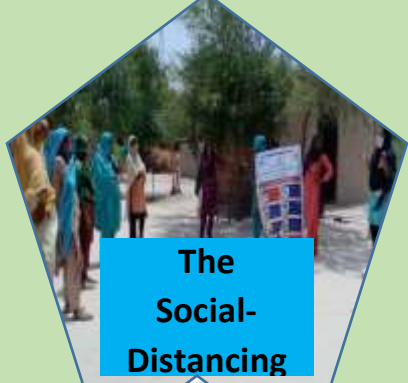

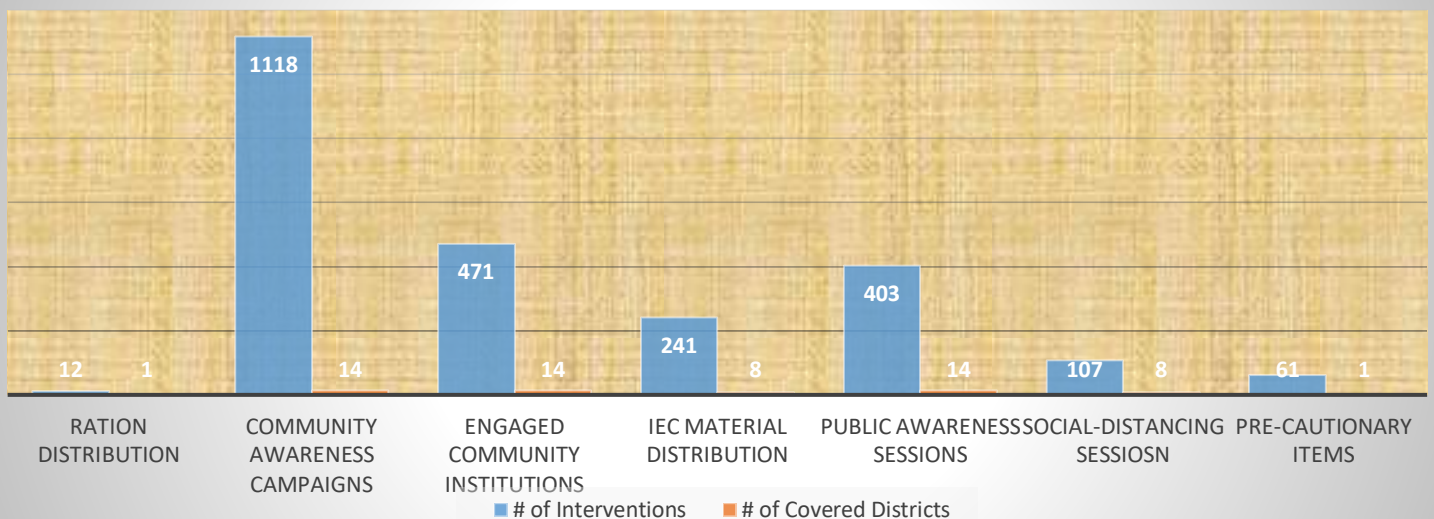
107, sessions on social-distancing aiming at behavioral changes were conducted in 8 SRSO-Out-Reach districts and 1,439 community members took part.

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2.1 RATION DISTRIBUTION AMONG POOR HOUSEHOLDS (HHs)

The current pandemic COVID-19 is affecting severally all segments of the society especially more poor households are more vulnerable like all other emergencies. The food is the foremost need of these poor HHs and government and other stakeholders have prime responsibility to fulfill this basic need on priority basis to support them for combating the emergency.

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) is supporting poor HHs in accessing to food in the out-reach districts. According to SRSO-Cumulative achievements till June 2020, total **17, 163**, Poor Households (HHs) were **distribution ration** in which provided **Cash Grant 1,072** and Ration **Bags 16,091** through community savings, local philanthropists and Govt. support. Meanwhile, **12, poor households (HHs)** were provided **Ration Bags** by utilizing community savings in 1 district during reporting period from June 1 to 15, 2020.

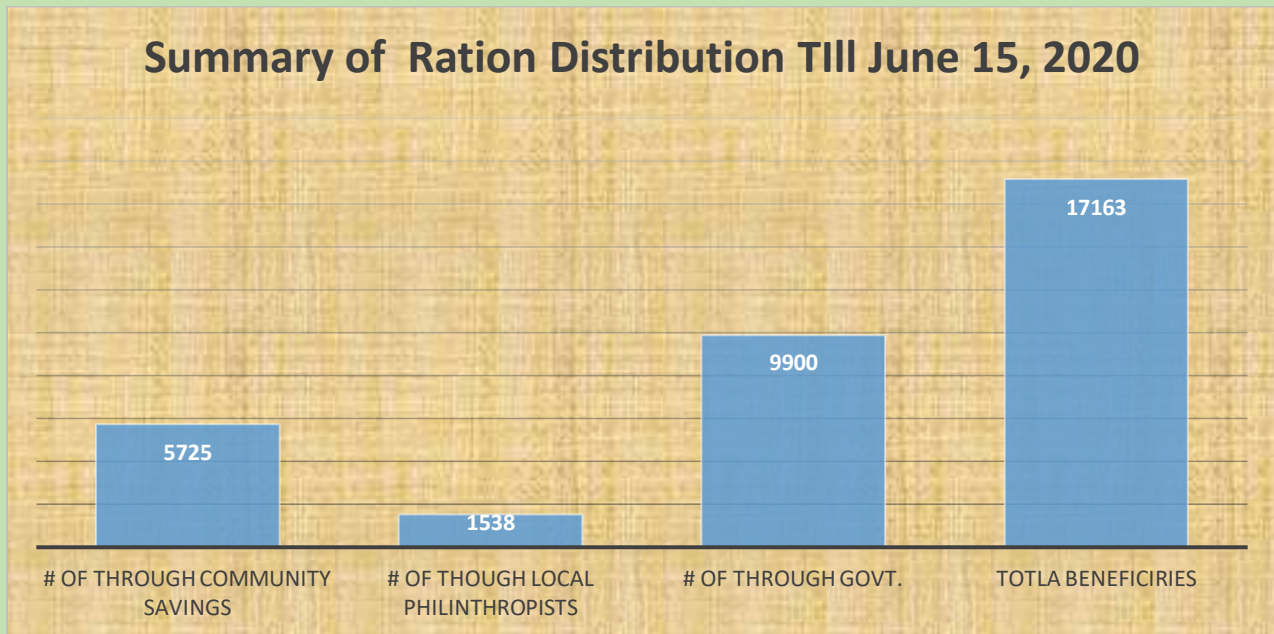

2.2 COMMUNITY AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS (CACs)

- **1, 118, Community Awareness Campaigns** were carried out in all 14 outreach districts of SRSO in Sindh.
- **4, 71 Community Institutions** (LSOs, VOs, COs) engaged to undertake COVID-19 awareness campaigns in all 14 SRSO-outreach districts of Sindh.
- **2, 41, IEC material** were distributed/displayed among the targeted communities in 8 SRSO-outreach districts of Sindh.
- **3, Public Announcements** were made using mobile/speakers in 2 SRSO-outreach districts of Sindh.
- **4, 03, Sessions** were undertaken with communities regarding to COVID-19 awareness raising in all 14 SRSO-outreach districts of Sindh.



The community awareness campaigns have been initiated under COVID-19 Emergency Response by SRSO to make aware communities about COVID-19 in order to take preventing measures for combating with pandemic in effective manner. Under these campaigns different types of initiatives i.e.; community sessions on COVID-19, social-distancing, hand-washing, IEC material dissemination and public announcements etc. have been planned and conducted by SRSO Teams and community institutions (CIs) at different levels especially targeted communities in the SRSO –out-reach areas of 14 districts in Sindh.

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) has planned & conducted to date June 15, 2020 total **29,161, Community awareness campaigns** on COVID -19 through **1,820 community volunteers** (community leaders, CRPs, etc.) and **13, 477 community institutions** (COs, VOs and LSOs) engaged on public awareness campaigns.

Meanwhile, from June 1 to 15, 2020 with the support of **471 community institutions (CIs)** total **1, 118 campaigns** have been conducted successfully in all 14 out-reach-districts of SRSO.

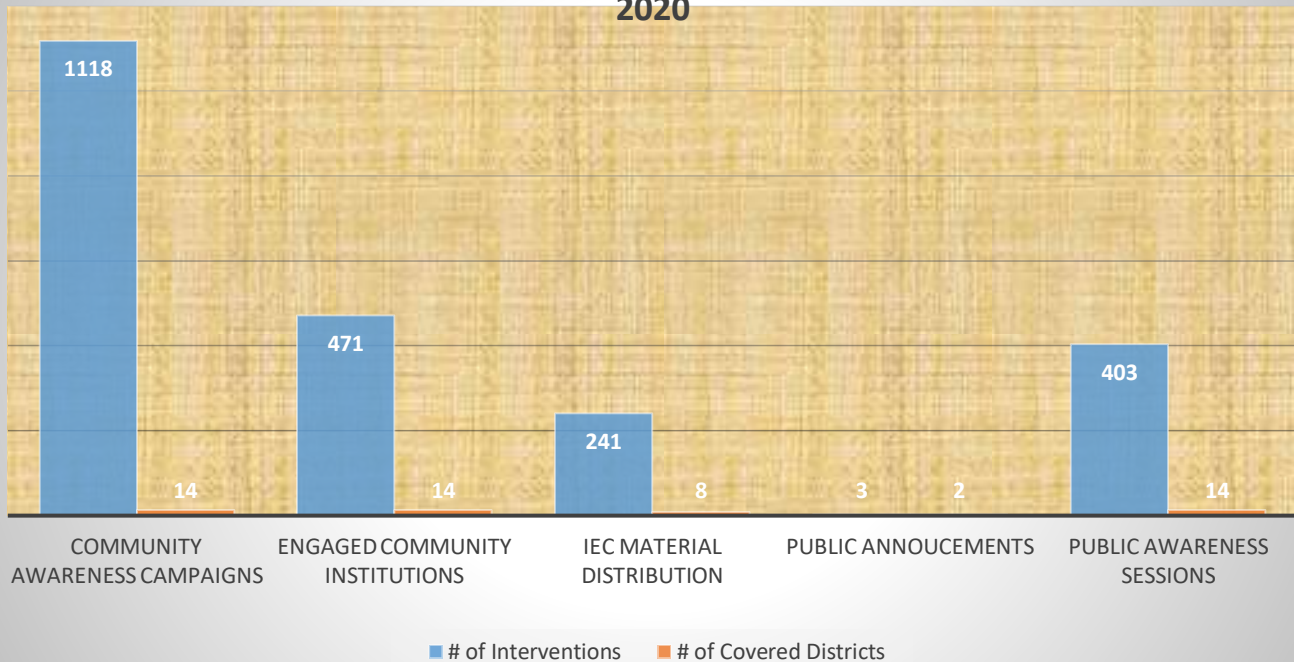

2.3 THE SOCIAL-DISTANCING SESSIONS AIMING FOR BEHAVIORAL CHNAGE

The social-distancing is another important public awareness initiative has been undertaking under COVID-19 Emergency Response at community level by Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO). The main purpose of this initiative is to be change behaviors of the community members through adopting social-distancing in everyday life to combat with COVID-19 pandemic.

According to SRSO-cumulative achievements to date June 15, 2020 total **7, 67, Social-Distancing Sessions** aiming at behavioral changes were conducted at community level in which **9,469 community members** have participated and made aware on COVID-19 and importance of social-distancing. Thus, during reporting period from June 1 to 15, 2020 total **107, sessions on social-distancing** were conducted in 8 SRSO-out-reach districts at community level and **1,439 community members** took part in these sessions.

2.4 PRE-CAUTIONARY ITEMS DISTRIBUTION AMONG COMMUNITIES FOR COMBATING WITH COVID-19 EMERGENCY

The pre-cautionary items distribution is an important intervening sector in the targeted communities of SRSO-outreach districts in order to combat current COVID-19 emergency in effective manner. In this regards, different precautionary items i.e.; face masks, soaps and sanitizers were distributed among communities, program beneficiaries and other stakeholders with the support of community institutions, formed business development groups (BDGs), and local philanthropists to support them into taking preventing measures against COVID-19 pandemic.

According to SRSO-Cumulative Achievements Data-base till June 15, 2020 total **21,054**, pre-cautionary Items have been distributed among the communities in which including **15,708 face masks**, **3,770 soaps**, and **1,576 sanitizers**. Meanwhile, during reporting period from June 1 to 15, 2020 total **61**, pre-cautionary Items were distributed among the communities in 1 SRSO-Outreach district which including **39 face masks**, **11 soaps**, and **10 sanitizers**.





2.5 ENGAGEMENT WITH DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION TO COMBAT WITH COVID-19 EMERGENCY

The engagement with district administration is an important role of SRSO and its community development institutions and they have played this role actively throughout COVID-19 emergency. The main purpose of the this engagement is to get and as well as provide support each other in the emergency response and combat with pandemic in proper and effective manner. The coordination meetings with district administration, getting MoUs, conduct training of CIs representatives on COVID-19 and implement at community level were conducted during this reporting period.

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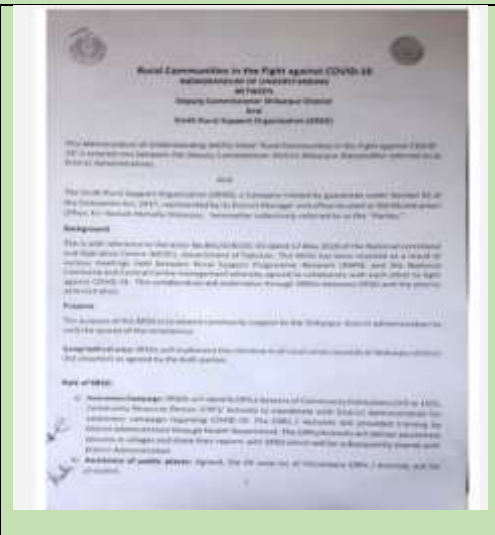
Community Mobilization and Awareness on COVID-19 under NCOC
