



COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE OVERALL INTERVENTIONS & ACHIEVEMENTS TILL JULY, 2020



A. RATION DISTRIBUTION:

17, 164 poor households (HHs) were **received the ration** including **Cash Grant 1,072** and **Ration Bags 16,092** through community savings, local philanthropists and Govt. support.

B. COMMUNITY AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS:

35,005 community awareness campaigns were conducted on COVID -19 through **2,900** community volunteers (community leaders, CRPs, etc.) and **15,582** community institutions (COs, VOs and LSOs) engaged on public awareness campaigns.

C. THE SOCIAL-DISTANCING:

962 Social-Distancing sessions aiming at behavioral changes were conducted at community level in which **12,572 community members** have participated and made aware in 14 out-reach districts.

D. PRE-CAUTIONARY ITEMS DISTRIBUTION

63,094 Pre-cautionary Items were distributed among the poor HHs of the targeted communities in which including 42,503 facemasks, 17,935 soaps, and 2,656 sanitizers.

E. REGISTRATION UNDER EHSAAS CASH PROGRAM:

194,824 potential beneficiaries were registered under EHSAAS Emergency Cash Programme in SRSO operational areas by community institutions and CRPs in 14 out-reach districts of Sindh.


F. SUPPORT TO GOVT. HEALTH FACILITIES:

3,940, items were provided to Govt. Health Facilities / four quarantine centers set up by local Authorities and one private medical center supported through the provision, cooked food, surgical masks, sanitizers, and soaps.








2. HIGH LIGHTS OF COVID-19 RESPONSE OF JULY 2020

- **3,732** community awareness campaigns were conducted on COVID -19 through **1,080** community volunteers (community leaders, CRPs, etc.) and **832** community institutions (COs, VOs and LSOs) engaged on public awareness campaigns in all 14 out-reach districts
- **99** Social-Distancing sessions aiming at behavioral changes were conducted at community level in which **1,925** community members have participated and made aware in 14 out-reach districts.
- **332** IEC Material i.e. standees and Pena flex on COVID-19 were developed, printed and displayed at local government, social welfare department and community places under HelpAge Project in 3 districts i.e; Karachi, Shikarpur and Jacobabad.
- **36,430** PPES (11,880 facemasks, 10,385 hand-gloves, and 14,165 soaps) were distributed among Agriculture Entrepreneurs, CRPs, and Communities under EU-Supported PINS in three districts i.e. Larkana, Kamber-Shahdadkot, and Shikarpur.
- **5,580** PPEs (4,500 surgical/facemasks and 1,080 sanitizers) were distributed among CRPs and community members under PSI-RSPN-DAFPAK Project in three districts i.e. Shikarpur, Jacobabad and Kamber-Shahdadkot.
- **1,080** CRPs (360 from each districts) were trained/oriented on COVID-19 under PSI-RSPN-DAFPAK Project in three districts i.e. Shikarpur, Jacobabad, and Kamber-Shahdadkot.









3,732 community awareness campaigns were conducted on COVID -19 through **1,080** community volunteers (community leaders, CRPs, etc.) and **832** community institutions (COs, VOs and LSOs) engaged on public awareness campaigns in all 14 out-reach districts.

IEC Material Dissemination

IEC material dissemination is an important activity under Community Awareness Campaigns (CACs) in order to make aware general public especially rural communities of program out-reach districts. In July 2020, total 777 IEC material items were disseminated and displayed as well in communities and government offices under NCOC agreement and HelpAge Project.



Public Announcements

The public announcements is another important initiative under community awareness campaigns. During July month, Community Institutions and Volunteers conducted 25 announcements using loudspeakers and megaphones and made 11 public announcements through using mosques/churches/mandirs. The main purpose of the public announcements is to make aware public of COVID-19 and its taking preventing measures.













The Social-Distancing Sessions Aiming at Behavioral Changes

99 community sessions were conducted which were participated by 1,925 community members during the month of July 2020. SRSO Team and Community Institutions (CIs) are conducting this activity on regular basis during routine visits, training sessions and other activities in order to make aware and sensitize to maintain social-distancing and taking preventing measures on their daily life.








IEC MATERIAL DEVELOPMENT & DISSEMINATION ON COVID-19 UNDER HELPAGE PROJECT

Under the HelpAge Project Promoting Rights of Older People, SRSO has developed and disseminated COVID-19 specific banners, and standees on the usage of facemask, social distancing, and standard operating procedures. This material was designed for social welfare, local government departments, and Old Person's Associations with the key message of taking care old age persons at meeting places during the COVID-19 pandemic. Meanwhile, IEC material was also displayed at Govt. offices, institutes; public and prominent places in communities of Karachi, Shikarpur, and Jacobabad districts, whose are working for the welfare of women, children, persons with disability and Old Age People. This IEC material displayed especially at Minister of Social welfare, local government, Jinnah hospital Karachi JPMC, Training Institute of Social Welfare department, Child Protection Unit and Orphanage center, OPAs other important offices and places of project's three out-reach districts.

COVID-19 RESPONSE UNDER PSI-RSPN-DAFPAK PROJECT

1,080 CRPs trained, 155 awareness sessions with VHCs, 205 in camps conducted, 25 public announcements made, 6,854 client screened, 4,500 surgical masks, and 1,080 sanitizers distributed successfully in three districts.

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) with their development partner Rural Support Program Network (RSPN) under the Project "Delivering Accelerated Family Planning in Pakistan (DAFPAK)" supported by Population Services International (PSI) has started the different initiatives to combat with COVID-19 pandemic. This purpose, CRPs training, awareness raising sessions with village health committees, public announcements, client screening and PPEs distribution have been started in three project districts i.e. Shikarpur, Jacobabad, and Kamber-Shahdadkot. CRPs are playing an effective role in mobilizing the rural communities, therefore 1,080 (360 from each district) have been trained through one-day training which was designed with the objective to sensitize and orientate as 'change agents' for prevention, control, and mitigation of the risks associated with the transmission of the COVID-19. During the training, CRPs were equipped with facemasks, hand-gloves, soaps, and IEC material for conducting sessions in the rural communities.


