11TH SARTYOON SANG MEGA CRAFTS EXHIBITION @ OCEAN MALL CLIFTON KARACHI (SINDH)

The three-day 11th Sartyoon Sang Mega Crafts Exhibition March 25-, 26, and 27, 2022 at Ocean Mall Clifton Karachi was organized by the Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) in collaboration with Sindh Government and other partners to display and promoting the work of rural artisans women of Sindh with an aims to provide the market place and linkages for their livelihood support.

In the exhibition, 9,188 products and crafts made by 1,572 members artisans of the SRSO formed, trained, and supported 95 Business Development Groups (BDGs) from 12 outreach districts of Sindh were showcased and marketed by rural artisan women.

A DISSEMINATION CONFERENCE ON FOSTERING WOMEN EMPOWERMENT AND LEADERSHIP UNDER SINDH UNION COUNCIL AND COMMUNITY ECONOMIC STRENGTHENING SUPPORT (SUCCESS) PROGRAMME ABOVE 800 ORGANIZED RURAL WOMEN OF COMMUNITY INSTITUTIONS ATTENDED THE CONFERENCE LARKANA/MARCH22,2022

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) and Rural Support Programmes Network (RSPN) jointly organized a Dissemination Conference on Fostering Women Empowerment and Leadership in collaboration with District Administration Larkana. The journey of the SUCCESS Programme towards women empowerment and reducing household poverty: key lessons and way forward were presented by leaders of community institutions, programme beneficiaries, SRSO Team, and other stakeholders. Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) under the EMO Hub Schools Project celebrated International Women's Day on March 8, 2022 at the school level in collaboration with the Education and Literacy Department-Govt. of Sindh. On this occasion, awareness-raising events on this year's theme "Gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow" were organized at SRSO managed Govt. High School Sami and GHS Numaish Colony Old Sukkur. Total 660 persons (115 at Sami and 545 at Numaish) from schools children, staff, SRSO staff, SMCs, education department, and other stakeholders attended the events. School students presented speeches, songs, role-play, and poems and tribute women's role in society and highlights issues and rights of women. Different stakeholders were invited including SMC, Educationists, and others. A documentary on gender equality was shown to participants and speeches were presented by girl students as well on the topic.

Speakers said the celebration of such events in our schools is a big contribution to women's empowerment. They urged that there is much need to make people aware of women's rights and gender equality.



The White Desert and the Water Carrier Solution as a blessing for Households 450 Water Carrier Wheels Distribution, donated by Tayaba Organization in White Desert of Sindh

Sanghar/March 31, 2022



The simple impact of water on wheels in the White desert of Sindh's Khipro Taluka of Sanghar district is a blessing because unfortunately, where water is available, quality and carrying through Matka/clay pots/ plastic jars remains a big issue. Indeed, mostly rural women are fulfilling this responsibility along with their children on their heads or on their bodies which causes different injuries and diseases. The situation in rural areas is even worse; eight out of 10 people in rural areas are deprived of the basic facility of water. Sindh only 15% had access to safe water in 2020. Sindh's white desert has the highest percentage of households' 89.7 percent without drinking water on-premises. They fetch water from a hand pump that is situated almost at a distance of one hour from their houses because there is a scarcity of water pulling and water wells in deserted areas. White desert rural women have a lot to struggle for Clean Drinking Water, so the Water Wheels from Tayaba Organization (International) is a blessing.

On dated 30-31st March 2022, SRSO with the collaboration of Tayaba Welfare Organization (International) donated 450 wheels that have been distributed successfully in the white desert area of Khipro Taluka. The event was organized by District Management SRSO, Team Leader PPRP Mr. Ghulam Rasool Samejo, and District Manager Mr. Irshad Ali Mallah along with government line department officials participated. These water wheels are like a miracle in saving time, efficient usage of water, the best solution for water reservation and enables women, children, and the elderly to collect four times more water than a single bucket by simply rolling it along the ground. Culturally, women and girls are responsible for collecting water for daily household needs, usually covering long distances every day to fetch water. Typically, these trips lead to insufficient water even to meet basic needs.

In the white desert, houses are far away from water sources, so people carry water to their homes often over long distances and this has proved to be time-consuming, especially for households. Carrying 40 liters of water once a day through water wheels is sufficient and necessary to practice basic hygiene including washing hands regularly and other household needs including drinking, cleaning, and cooking. Irrigating small-scale food gardens (Home Garden especially kitchen gardening promoting organic improved nutrition for covering food security) is critical to sustain families and encourage them to cultivate their food while the severely affected economy recovers. Women have to make multiple trips. To collect water for regular usages, such as washing my family's clothes, indeed, now it will change the role as men are also sitting and saying that they are ready to take on the primary role so the women are freed up to do other things. Or the role is split so men use it four days a week and the women use it two days. It has reduced the burden on women. H2O (Help to Others) Water wheels have eased the burden on women and during distribution, women were given a proper session on how to use the water wheels, their cleaning, their proper filling, and to maintain at the household level. One Woman during distribution told that in our village on routine basis girls and women carrying plastic jerry cans of water on their heads is a common sight in rural areas but now our males can also carry this water easily because there is a myth that Matka/Clay pot is carried by women on their heads so the water Wheels eases that burden by storing water in a round 40-liter that doubles as a wheel.

In last, all women paid thanks to Tayaba Org anization for blessing such a blessed product.

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) in partnership with Forest Department-Govt. of Sindh celebrated “World forest Day” under the EU funded Programme for Improved Nutrition in Sindh (PINS-ER-3) on March 21, 2022, at Kamber-Shahdadkot. The main purpose of the event was to celebrate world forest day to provide a platform to all stakeholders and aware them about the importance of the plants and forests in lives of people, keeping the clean and green environment and fulfill nutritional needs of women and children.

100 Community Institutions leaders and children participated in the event. This event was attended by various Govt department representatives i.e Mr. Shahnawaz Siyal (Range Forest Officer), Mr. Ashraf Ali Khokhar (Forest Incharge), Mr. Waqar Ahmed (District Officer Child Protection Social Welfare Department), Mr. Abdul Rauoof Magsi (Director Agriculture Extension), Mr. Musawar Nazeer Kalhoro(Assistant Engineer PHED), Mr . Key speakers said that “Tree plantation is one of the key strategies to address climate change, fruit-bearing trees also provide food to humans, animals, birds, etc. and through this initiative, rural communities are encouraged to take part in the larger campaign and raise awareness regarding the dire need for environmental initiatives ensuring an abundance of food for future generations.”

The plantation of fruit-bearing trees drive was started from 1st March to 20 March 2022 by SRSO as part of the Program for Improved Nutrition in Sindh (ER-III nutrition-sensitive component). For this purpose, from Sindh Forest Department 11,000 fruit plants were received, distributed, and planted among various LSOs.

Fruit trees were also planted in school by children and teachers and at the end of the program prizes were also distributed among school children that performed good speech and tablos.

According to an agreement of SRSO with Sindh Forest Department-GoS 50,000 fruits plants have been distributed among communities through Community Institutions (CIs) in 03 PINS programs districts Shikapur, Larkana, and Kamber-Shahdadkot. Fruit plants were also distributed during the event among participants to plant, care and grow a tree at their home.

At present, SRSO is implementing the EU-funded "Programme for Improved Nutrition in Sindh" (PINS- ER-III) in partnership with RSPN and technical assistance of ACF in Larkana, Kamber-Shahdadkot, and Shikarpur districts. The overall objective of the programme (PINS) is to sustainably improve the nutritional status of children under five and pregnant and lactating women (PLWs) in Sindh.
