Celebration of World Malaria Day under the SRSO-GFATM Malaria Project

At present, SRSO is implementing GFATM Malaria Project in partnership with the National Rural Support Programme (NRSP) in the Larkana and Kamber-Shahdadkot districts. The goal of the project is to reduce of malaria burden by 20% in 60 endemic districts by 2023. Meanwhile, the specific objectives of the project are: i) ensure and sustain universal coverage of multi prevention services to populations at risk in targeted districts, ii) ensure and sustain 80% coverage of quality assured early diagnosis, prompt treatment services to the population at risk in targeted districts, iii) increase community awareness up to 80% on the benefits of early diagnosis, prompt treatment and malaria preventive measures using health promotion, advocacy, and BCC interventions, and iv) ensure availability of quality-assured strategic information for informed decision making.

Director-General PPRP-Directorate Govt. of Sindh Mr. Parvez Ahmed Chandio, and Assistant Mr. Abid Hussain Mahar visited ongoing PPRP interventions in 6 program districts i.e Khairpur Mirs, Sanghar, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Badin and Thatta on April 11, 12, 18, 19, 20 and 21, 2022 respectively. 137 adolescent learners have completed primary graduation by attending three packages of primary course components Package - A (for Grades Katchi & 1) started in August 2017 and was completed in August 2018. Package - B (for Grades II & III) lasted from September 2018 to December 2019. Package - C (for Grades IV & V) has been started in January 2020 and lasted till July 2021. The learners were been equipped with necessary primary schooling knowledge; interpersonal skills and disposition by integrating communicative practices and interactive lectures.

First harvest of Zinc Bio fortified Wheat crop in district Larkana and Kamber Shahdadkot under the European Union supported Programme for Improved Nutrition in Sindh (#PINS) implemented by #SRSO to support and complement Government of Sindh's Accelerated Action Plan for Reduction of Stunting and Malnutrition.

The seed provided by SRSO (Recommended seed by PARC), with an objective to introduce #zincol variety to replicate by other farmers in the vicinity as people can use this variety on a regular basis. The consumption of biofortified high zinc #wheat would enable the rural malnourished communities to raise their zinc nutrition level.

We are very proud of our communities managing this pilot so well and have Zinc Biofortified Wheat crop.

Meanwhile, Mr. Maqsood Alam Kolachi PC ECHO presented Targets vs. Achievements of ECHO 9 activities in detail with the pictorial presentation. Finally, it was decided to expedite the process of activities as we may accomplish the target within the timeline and budget consumption.

An idea was floated from RGM SRSO regarding establishing a Disaster Risk Reduction Resource Centre at the UC level in targeted 10 UCs and decided that SRSO will provide a concept note and submit to the ACF team for further process.

The delegation visited villages Khamiso Samo & Wahid Dino Shoro UC Bajora for cascade training of Community based Disaster Risk Management where CRP was conducting training in a good manner. They observed tree plantations in the village. Mr. Fayaz Ali Vistro Range Forest Officer Social Forestry Department and Focal Person of ECHO in tree plantation drive activities. He had given input to the community regarding tree plantation during the visit of this delegation. ACF team appreciated cascade training and tree plantation activities in these villages.



Fire Incidents and SRSO's Immediate Emergency Response

District Dadu Date April 20, 2022

In the month of April 2022 a horrific and shocking incident of fire occurred in village Faiz Muhammad Chandio Taluka Meharr District Dadu and destroyed 150 houses completely and human bodies and livestock as well. This is a very terrible incident of fire in the recent history of Sindh and shocked everyone. All segments of Society and Government got great sorrow and want to take responsibility and responded according as well.

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) has responded to provide relief to the fire-affected village Faiz Muhammad Chandio Taluka Meharr District Dadu. In this regard, the SRSO team visited the affected village and assessed the situation and immediate needs. Initially, 15 temporary toilets have been established to provide safe sanitary facilities to 79 households especially women in the affected village. These toilets have been established near the tents/camps of the affected families. The locations were identified with the consultation of the affected households. SRSO has also coordinated with the administration and other stakeholders to take emergency steps to provide relief.



District Khairpur April, 2022

Thatched houses and valuable property, including livestock and grain, were reduced to ashes, and fire broke out in villages in Sindh's Khairpur district at the various locations. SRSO responded immediately to affected and needy People from different villages of District Khairpur who were directly affected after the Fire and burned their whole houses and Assets. Food Items Ration for families Ration consist of a daily consumable product like Chaki Aata, Cooking oil, Sugar, Iodized Salt, Soaps and Vital Tea somehow other consumables products are given per family, therefore, Assessment has been done and given the Ration to the needy and affected families through proper by followed the proper SOPs.

70 most affected poor households were supported in occurred fire incidents in 6 Talukas of the district. Rations bags for fire-affected families were given and also supported with non-food items like clothes, and traditional rillies were given.



District Umerkot Date

April 22, 2022

On 22nd April 2022 around 2:30 PM a sudden fire incident took place at Hajam Mohalla Village Salik Bajeer UC Kharoro Syed, where many houses were fully burned to ashes along with all goods and furniture.

The fire brigade vehicles reached after almost 1.5 hours so in this time many losses occurred and the community with themselves and the fire brigade vehicle controlled on fire after many hours. Village Organization has informed to SRSO team and in response, the SRSO team visited village Salik Bajeer on an immediate basis for relief work. The team conducted meeting with community members and got the details about the fire incident.

Sindh Rural Support Organization supported the fire of affected families of village Salik Bajeer. SRSO provided the cheque of PKR 10,000 per family. A total of 07 cheques were distributed.



District Badin Date 29th of April 2022

On dated 29th of April 2022, fire incidents occurred at two places i.e., village Luwari Sharif Talpur Mohala, Union Council Luwari Sharif, and ward no. 06 village Abu Shekha Union Council Haji Soomar Abro Tehsil and District Badin. Cumulatively, 26 households were severely affected by the fire incident in which the loss of home assets and livestock happened.

After the completion of the assessment, 26 ration bags containing items such as; Flour (20 kg), Rice (18 kg), Oil (05 liters), Lentils (05 kg), and Vermicelli (5 Packs) were distributed among the affected households of the fire incidents. Besides that, stitched clothes and quilts prepared under the VTP component of Sindh Rural Support Organization were also provided to the households in presence of Mr. Najeeb-u-Rehman ADC-1 and SRSO Regional General Manager Dr. Ghulam Rasool Samejo.

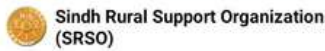
