THE TANGIBLE HEIFERS' ASSETS WERE HANDED-OVER TO 144 SELECTED ULTRA-POOR HOUSEHOLDS

KASHMORE @KANDHLOT AND SHIKAPUR/JUNE 29, 2022

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) handed over the 144 tangible heifers assets among the ultra-poor households (HHs) in Kashmore@Kandhkot and Shikarpur districts on dated June 29, 2022. These productive assets were distributed under the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD)funded National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP)- Govt. of Pakistan to support ultra-poor households' livelihood on a sustainable basis. On this occasion, distribution ceremonies were organized with selected beneficiaries and Regional General Manager Mr. Rustam Ali Soomro and District Managers briefed them about the programme, its purpose, developed Livelihood Investment Plan, livestock insurance, etc. Before, distribution all heifers were vaccinated and properly tagged as well.

1st ceremony was organized at Kashmore@ Kandhlot where a total of 53 heifers were handed-over to selected ultra-poor households of district Kashmore@Kandhkot. Meanwhile, 2nd distribution was also organized in district Shikarpur in which 91 tangible heifers assets were distributed according to set protocols and procedures.

At present SRSO is implementing National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP) with the support of the Government of Pakistan and The International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), in Shikarpur and Kashmore@Kandhkot districts. The overall goal of the Programme is to assist the ultra-poor and very poor in graduating out of poverty on a sustainable basis, simultaneously improving their overall food security, nutritional status, and resilience to climate change.





THE BROOKE PAKISTAN-SUPPORTED EQUINE WELFARE PROJECT

The consultation session with Brick Kilns Owner Association on equine animals' needs

Sindh Rural Support Organization organized a consultative session with Brick Kilns Owner Associations on equine animals' needs under The Brooke Pakistan supported Equine Welfare Project at Ranipur district Khairpur. 30 Brick kiln owners participated in the session. The main purpose of the activity was to discuss with BKs owners to provide welfare resources for equines like; proper shade/shelter, availability of clean and fresh water, availability of water, plant different trees and prepare and maintain a first aid kit, containing necessary medicines for first aid, in their respective BKs. The expected outcome of this activity is that BKs owners will take steps the provide proper rest places for animals, availability of clean and fresh water, and in-time first aid treatment for animals. Dr. Sher Nawaz Khan Regional Manager Brooke Pakistan South Region Karachi and Dr. Naimatullah Soomro (Community Animals Health Officer Hyderabad) also attended the session.

Dr. Siraj Munner Ansari ((Community Animals Health Officer Khairpur/Sukkur SRSO) welcomed and shared an introduction of the Equine Welfare Project, objectives, activities and core values. He also shared a presentation about the importance of Equine animals, the value of the working horse. Mule & Donkey, some

work types shared, discussion on five welfare domain,



Dr. Sher Nawaz Khan, started with the introduction of the Brooke Pakistan and he said we are working for more than 30 vears in Pakistan. Mr. Ali Asghar Maitlo (SRSO Manager NRM and Project Focal Person) shared ideas and solutions to fulfill equine needs and thanked all participants and Brooke team members for their participation and committed their promises to take welfare steps for equine animals.

organized three days training for Senior Medical
Officers to strengthen malaria interventions under
the GFATM project in Kamber Shahdadkot District.

Kamber-Shahdadkot/June29, 2022

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) under GFATM Project organized three days COMBO Training on Uncomplicated Malaria Case Management, Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT), and Malaria Information System (MIS). The training was organized in SRSO District Conference Hall dated from 27th to 29th of June 2022. Participation of twelve senior medical officers and medical Superintended hailing from DHQ Kamber, THQ Warah, THQ Mirokhan, THQ Shahdadkot, RHC Qubo Saeed Khan, RHC Wagan, and RHC Nasirabad was observed actively.

The training aimed at improving the capacities of Medical Officers to combat the challenge of low screening and strengthening malaria interventions in the Kamber Shahdadkot District.

Contextually District Kamber Shahdadkot is being intervened under the GFATM project through the provision of Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT) kits, Anti Malaria Drugs, and LLINs (Malaria prevention nets) and capacity building of health care providers to strengthen malaria interventions in Kamber Shahdadkot District.

Under the SRSO-GFATM Project in Kamber Shahdadkot sixty-one (61) BHUs and GDs, twenty-two (22) private clinics and nine (9) microscopy centers resulting in ninety-one (91) health facilities are being provided free Anti-malarial drugs, Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT) kits and LLINs to consolidate malaria control interventions to reduce the incidence of high malaria cases in District.

The training was imparted by master trainer Dr. Habibullah Shah chaired by District Health Officer (DHO) Kamber Shahdadkot and supervised by Dr. Muhammad Nawaz Kamlani District Incharge Data Management Unit Malaria, and Mr. Mansoor Ali Brohi District MEAL Officer VBD-District Kamber Shahdadkot.





At present, SRSO is implementing GFATM Malaria Project in partnership with the National Rural Support Programme (NRSP) in the Larkana and Kamber-Shahdadkot districts. The goal of the project is to reduce of malaria burden by 20% in 60 endemic districts by 2023. Meanwhile, the specific objectives of the project are: i) ensure and sustain universal coverage of multi prevention services to populations at risk in targeted districts, ii) ensure and sustain 80% coverage of quality assured early diagnosis, prompt treatment services to the population at risk in targeted districts, iii) increase community awareness up to 80% on the benefits of early diagnosis, prompt treatment and malaria preventive measures using health promotion, advocacy, and BCC interventions, and iv) ensure availability of quality-assured strategic information for informed decision making.

INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT (IMSD)

SRSO-Institute of Management and Skill Development (IMSD) organized 2- Day Training Workshop on Effective Presentation Skills for senior and mid-level management staff on June 2 & 3, 2022 at SRSO Complex Sukkur. The main objective of the training was to enhance presentation skills in order to develop, design, and deliver effectively. This workshop was attended by 31 staff members based at head office and districts from different sectors and programs i.e. Micro Finance, SSS, Finance, HR, IMSD, MER, CED, Micro Health Insurance, Procurement, Risk, and Compliances. 1st day Mr. Asif Khuhro (Chief Financial Officer-CFO) inaugurated the training. They said, "this is a very important topic and essential professional skill for each staff especially managers and so hoped well for best learning from the training." Then, each participant introduces themself with their name, designation, project/sector, frequency of delivering presentations, and key areas of improvement in the context of the presentation. Then trainer concluded the shared introductions and identified key training needs. Then, she briefed about 2 days of training on presentation skills and said that training will enable participants to;

i)Plan and prepare presentation

ii)Deliver an exceptional presentation

iii)Skillfully handle difficult questions and situations

iv)Overcome negative stress and gain confidence in your presentation skills

The 2-day training was comprised of 3 core parts. Part 1: of the training developing the presentation (selecting and narrowing the topic, developing central ideas, generating main ideas, and gathering supporting material. Part 2: organizing and outlining your presentation (organizing main ideas, organizing supporting material, organizing for the ear, standard presentation format, visual aids). Part 3: Deliver your presentation (manuscript speaking, memorized speaking, impromptu speaking, and extemporaneous speaking).

Training used interactive training methodology to engage each participant to share their views, ideas and learning and raise questions and provide their feedback about training contents and methodology. Each participant has given a task to prepare and deliver a presentation for staff in the shared guideline i.e. intro, body, and conclusion within the given time. Trainer highlighted the key strengths and areas of improvement of each participant and discussed accordingly to overcome and develop, design, and deliver a good presentation.

In the final session, participants shared their feedback regarding discussed training content and used training methodology. Trainer and logistics arrangements as well. Most of the participant's training was great exploring learning from the shared presentations by the trainer and participants as well. Training methodology. Finally, Mr. Niaz Hingro (Sr. Manager-IMSD) concluded the training and thanked all participants for their active participation.

Ms. Asmat Batool (Deputy Chief Management Counselor) Pakistan Institute of Management (PIM) Islamabad office conducted this training. She has 14 years of experience in designing and delivering training for different stakeholders from government to private and civil society. Whereas Mr. Zubair Soomro (Manager-IMSD) hosted the training.

Fire Incidents and SRSO's Immediate Emergency Response June, 2022

Mirpurkhas/June 6, 2022



Fire incidents are frequently occurring during the current heat wave in different parts of Sindh. On dated 3rd June 2022 a horrified Fire incident happened in the village of Mir Muhammad Talpur, Union Council Soofan Shah Taluka Digri District Mirpurkhas, where 19 houses of the Meghwar community were fully burned. Due to this incident, 19 houses fully burned their clothes, food items, and livestock fodder, and 20 goats and 03 Cows also were dead which were their main livelihood sources.

The Sindh Rural Support Organization Taluka Digri District Mirpurkhas team visited a village and physically verified the conditions to assess the damages and immediate needs of the affected families and decided to take immediate emergency relief work. For this purpose on June 6, 2022, SRSO fostered Local Support Organization Chand union council Sofan Shah Taluka Digri distributed relief items i.e. ration bags and ladies' dresses among the affected 19 families.

Assistant Commissioner Digri Mr. Asif Khaskheli distributed the Ration Bags and Clothes among the affected families, he shared his views regarding SRSO efforts of SRSO and expressed his regrets over the incident and said that we were sad "to hear the news of the incident is very tragic and this ration could not compensate for such a huge loss. SRSO always helps the poor people immediately in case of any incident and responds promptly to deal with the situations."



Sukkur IBA University Relief Work Mirpurkhas/June 09, 2022



The Sukkur Institute of Business Administration University team Mr. Zain ul Abdeen and Ms. Hira Awan along with the SRSO Mirpurkhas Team and Assistant commissioner Dighri Mr. Asif Khaskheli visited the village Mir Muhammad Talpur Taluka Dighri and met with fire-affected families. On 3rd June 2022, 19 families were severely affected by the fire incident and lost their food, livestock shade including 20 goats, 3 cows died as well as cattle fodder, clothes, jewelry, money and a man of the family was also injured and his hands burnt in the fire.

The SRSO informed Sukkur IBA University about the incident and requested for assistance to the poorest fire-affected families of **SRSO** foster Community institutions (CIs) under PPRP-Govt. of Sindh. On the request, IBA university officials decided to provide financial assistance to fire-affected families as a relief to meet basic needs by disbursing 6,000 cash per family. Sukkur IBA disbursed a total of 114,000 PKR cash amount among 19 affected families in the presence of the Assistant Commissioner and CIs members.

In the end, Assitant Commissioner Dighri appreciated Sukkur IBA and SRSO for this relief work and encouraged the affected families and said that "we have tried our best to help the affected families so that they can cope with this difficult situation and recover themselves."
