MEC is mainly focusing on quality management tools to keep a watch on the progress of development schemes Peoples' Poverty Reduction Program to proactively raise an alert where interventions are required by the decision taking authorities. Advocacy and Networking meetings of LSOs with Taluka Administration regarding response to Disasters under SIDA-ACF funded Project

At present, SRSO is implementing SIDA-funded Building Resilient Communities by Connecting and Emergency Response to Sustainable Development Project in partnership with ACF at Mirpurkhas, Badin, and Thatta districts. The goal of the project is to provide emergency life-sustaining assistance to disaster-affected communities in Sindh through food security and livelihood (FSL) and resilience-building interventions including psychosocial support interventions.

The Advocacy and networking meetings were organized between Local Support Organizations and Taluak Administration under the SIDA-funded Building Resilient Communities by Connecting and Emergency Response to Sustainable Development Project. Total 04 meetings were conducted at Taluka Mirpur Sakro and Thatta (District Thatta) Taluka Jhudho (District Mirpurkhas) and Taluka Badin (District Badin) on August 26, 27, and 28, respectively at Assistant Commissioner's Offices. All meetings were presided by Assistant Commissioner and attended by 35 representatives of 17 LSOs of targeted 17 Union Councils of three project districts.

5th 7-Days Training of Trainers (TOT) Workshop for Community Resource Persons (CRPs) on Enterprise Development, Assets Management, Financial and Functional Literacy.

SRSO Complex Sukkur/ August2 to 8, 2021

SRSO-Institute of Management and Skill Development (IMSD) organized successfully 5th 7-days Training of Trainers (ToT) on Enterprise Development, Assets Management, Financial and Functional Literacy from August 2 to 8, 2021, at SRSO Complex Sukkur under the National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP)-Government of Pakistan. This 7-days training of trainers workshop was attended by selected 29 (21 males and 8 females) Community Resource Persons (CRPs) of both Programme districts Shikarpur and Kashmore@Kandhkot.

These master trainers have been trained and capacitated mainly all aspects of enterprise development through using different participatory and interactive training tools and techniques.

On the first day, Mr. Muzaffar Panhwar' (PM-SRSO-NPGP) shared opening remarks, and last day participated and distributed the training certificates among the participants. Training Consultant Mr. Imtiaz Ahmed Pirzado facilitated the training meanwhile Mr. Zubair Soomro (Manager-IMSD) was the focal person for the overall coordination and management of the workshop.

SRSO has initiated a compressive training program on enterprise development for CRPs under the NPGP-GoP. Initially, 132 CRPs of both districts (2 from each selected UC) have been identified as Economic CRPs and their Training of Trainers (TOT) have been started by SRSO-IMSD. For this purpose, a comprehensive training manual has been also developed with the help of a training consultant. They have been trained in a 7 days comprehensive training that includes mainly; functional literacy, financial literacy, and basic business management, and assets management. These trained 132 Economic CRPs master trainers will be replicated this training with 32,549 tangible assets beneficiaries of the Programme in both districts through a 3 days training.


