Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) under the RSPN-ECHO-HIP-COVID-19 Project handed over PPEs to Chandika Medical Hospital Larkana and District Health Hospital Shikarpur. 8,055 surgical masks for doctors and paramedics, 840 N-95 Masks for doctors and paramedic working in emergency, 195 gowns (reusable) for doctors, paramedics, and janitorial staff, 195 goggles (reusable) for doctors, paramedics, and janitorial staff, 8,055 exam gloves (pair) for doctors and paramedics, 27.75 heavy-duty gloves (pair) for janitorial staff, 402.75 hand sanitizers (150ml) for doctors and paramedics, and 03 chlorine tabs)500gms) for janitorial staff.

Currently, SRSO is implementing the "Support Government of Sindh (GoS) to prepare for and respond to COVID-19 Pandemic" Project under the ECHO-HIP funding in collaboration with RSPN in Larkana and Shikarpur Districts. The key objective of this project is to support and respond to the Government of Sindh in addressing, responding, and mitigating the suffering of the people of Sindh. Under the project 100 hand-washing stations establishment, PPEs distribution with the district health department, LSOs, and CRPs training on COVID, public awareness, specious cases testing and other initiatives have been undertaking in both targeted districts.

Sustaining Adolescents Participation in Community Institutions to Address Child Marriages and Create Awareness among Adolescents on COVID-19 in Ghotki and Khairpur.

101 representatives of five LSOs have been oriented on Child Marriages and COVID-19 through One-Day Orientations in five targeted Union Councils of District Ghotki during December 2020



Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) district Ghotki has organized successfully 05 one-day orientations of selected 5 Local Support Organizations in the targeted 05 UCs of the district Ghotki with the partnership of Rural Support Programme Network (RSPN) under the UNICEF supported the project. The key objective of the orientations was to orient LSOs representatives about adolescent issues especially child marriages, violence against children, and COVID-19 preventative measures.

These orientations were organized and facilitated by the SRSO district team and RSPN Project Team jointly and Project Manager RSPN and District Manager-SRSO were lead facilitators. 101 women representatives of 05 LSOs have been oriented about adolescent issues especially child marriages, violence against children, and COVID-19 preventative measures during the month of December. Now, the oriented LSO representatives are mobilizing adolescents and creating awareness among the communities' especially adolescent issues and COVID-19 preventive measures.

Before orientation, Project Focal Person Mr, Akram Shaikh, and SR. Manager-MER-Mr. Naveed visited district Office Ghotki on December 9, 2020, and oriented the district team about planned orientations.

SRSO has initiated this project with the partnership of Rural Support Programme Network m(RSPN) with the support of UNICEF in Chotki and Khairpur districts in order to strengthen community institutions for their role to address adolescent related issues including child marriages, violence against children and create awareness among adolescent on COVID-19.

Office Shikarpur transferred Productive Assets to 15 Ultrapoor beneficiaries under the National Poverty Graduation Programme-Government of Pakistan on 3 & 11 December 2020. The productive assets included; 30 Karyana items at Kashmore and 10 lowddar-rakshas (phatta), 4 Changchi, and one Mobile Oil Shop Material were handed over to poor families of Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP) of the district Shaikarpur, which has been identified and finalized through a transparent and standard procedure. The main purpose of asset distribution among the ultra-poor households is to provide livelihood support to BISP beneficiaries as they can graduate from the vicious cycle of poverty on a sustainable basis. Mr. Muzafar Pahnwar Programme Manager, District Managers SRSOand DPOs-NPGP also visited the distribution. Before distribution, selected families have been oriented about NPGP and assets safety and management protocols. On this occasion, the procurement committee, community institutions, and SRSO representatives were also present and supervised, and facilitated the whole process.

SRSO is implementing National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP), in partnership with Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund (PPAF), with the support of the Government of Pakistan and The International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), in Shikarpur and Kashmore@Kandhkot districts since 2019. The overall goal of the Programme is to assist the ultra-poor and very poor in graduating out of poverty on a sustainable basis, simultaneously improving their overall food security, nutritional status, and resilience to climate change.


