JANUARY 26, 27 AND 28, 2021 @ LARKANA, SHIKARPUR, AND KAMBER-SHAHDADKOT DISTRICTS

Mr. Zulfiqar Ali Mithani Deputy Country Director (DCD), Action Against Hunger (ACF) Pakistan along with other delegation members Dr. Rano Mal Provisional Head ACF, Mr. Shahid Rajput (Sr. Manager) ACF ECHO-HIP COVID Project, and Mr. Javed Memon Sr. Div. Manager-ACF and visited various interventions carried out under PINS-ER-II and ER-III and ECHO-COVID-19 Project in targeted 3 districts. On the first day, he visited district Larkana and met LSO "SINDHU DARYA" general body members. LSO CBK had a detailed presentation on SRSO fostered LSO work in SUCCESS, PINS ER2, PINS ER III, and ECHO-HIP Projects. He held discussions with LSO members about community issues and faced challenges in implementation.

On the last day, VO Mir Muhammad Kundan Sing at UC Dhamirah Tahseel Naseerabad. The purpose of the visit was to observe the integration of PINS ER II & PINS III activities. A delegation of the EU-SUCCESS Technical Team, which was consisting of a renowned economist Dr. Kaiser Bengali and Ms. Hina Shahid paid a visit to the SRSO enterprise-oriented- interventions carried out under the Government of Sindh supported PPRP in district Thatta. They asked different questions from members of BDG on expenses of inputs and outputs, net profit and its utilization, future planning for enhancement.

The delegation also met with beneficiaries of making wooden baskets and Karyana shop CIF and IGG support in VO Ithad. They also visited the SRSO district office and de-briefed about the visit. They appreciated the SRSO interventions under SRSO-GoS regarding reducing poverty from rural communities with communities.

JANUARY 31, 2021 @ LARKANA AND SHIKARPUR

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) is implementing with the partnership of Rural Support Programme Network (RSPN) ECHO-HIP-COVID-19 Project in order to respond and support the Government of Sindh in two districts: Larkana and Shikarpur. One of the most important interventions is to conduct “Mobile Sample Collection Testing of COVID-19” in collaboration with Rapid Response Teams under the supervision of DHO offices in respective districts. SRSO is dedicatedly working to spread awareness in far-flung areas/remote areas to convince people that Coronavirus is a reality and it is lethal. SRSO is working through trained LSO representatives and Local Resource Persons (CRPs) for mobilizing, awareness-raising, motivating communities, and organizing Corona Testing Camps in rural areas. According to the report up to January 31, 2021 2240 cases (1037 Larkana and 1237 Shikarpur) have been tested through this sample collection. It is necessary to follow SOPs and mentally ready to come forward for testing. The grassroots level experience tells that if people are mobilized and oriented properly keeping in view their local context and culture, then results are quite satisfactory.

SRSO is implementing the project with the partnership of RSPN “Support Government of Sindh (GoS) to Prepare for and Respond to COVID-19 Pandemic”, in consortium with Action Against Hunger (ACF) and PPHI through ECHO HIP funding in Larkana and Shikarpur districts.

January 25, 26, and 27, 2021 @ District Kashmore-Kandhkot



Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) District Kashmore-Kandhkot Office transferred the 124 productive assets to the ultra-poor families under the Government of Pakistan supported National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP). On January 25, 2021, the Kashmore team has distributed 66 assets including 18 heifers, 28 Bikes with milk containers, and 20 Loader Bikes, 2nd Day January 26, 2021, distributed 58 assets including 34 heifers, 16 confectionary Bikes, 4 Bikes with milk containers, 3 Loader Bikes, and 1 Bike for Chicken sell and on 3rd day January 27, 2021, distributed 51 assets including 10 heifers, 6 fruit/vegetable Bikes and 35 Loader Bikes among the ultra-poor families of BISP of district Kashmore-Kandhkot.

**POVERTY SCORE CARD (PSC) SURVEY STARTED IN
EXPANDED DISTRICTS GHOTKI AND SUKKUR OF
PEOPLES' POVERTY REDUCTION PROGRAMME
(PPRP)-GOVT. OF SINDH.**

January 13 and 14, 2021 @ Sukkur and Ghotki

SRSO-Monitoring, Evaluation, and Research Unit (MER-U) have initiated a Poverty Score Card (PSC) survey for the Peoples' Poverty Reduction Programme (PPRP)-Government of Sindh in the expanded Programme districts Ghotki and Sukkur. For this purpose, Enumerators Orientations/training for Android-based Poverty Scorecard (PSC) Survey has been conducted in both districts. The main objective of the orientation was to enable the enumerators on the basics of the survey and PSC techniques i.e. Survey intro, household definition, identification, and door marking, survey quality protocols, and application usage.

The first training of first batches of PPRP- PSC teams have been organized on 13 and 14 January 2021 at Sukkur, and Ghotki and trained 15 female enumerators at Sukkur and 14 at Ghotki and they have started the survey process. Mr. Naveed Memon Sr. Manager-MER-U and Mr. Sona Khan SPO-MER-Unit and Mr. Amjid Tunio-MIS-PPRP-SRSO have facilitated these trainings and now, are facilitating and coordinating teams in the survey as well.
