SINDH RURAL SUPPORT ORGANIZATION (SRSO) HAS BEEN INITIATED THE DISTRIBUTION OF FRUIT TREES AND CONDUCTED COMMUNITY WORKSHOPS AMONG THE RIVERINE COMMUNITIES IN DISTRICT SUKKUR AND SBAUNDER SUSTAINABLE FOREST MANAGEMENT (SFM), UNDP-GEF PROJECT, IMPLEMENTING BY MINISTRY OF CLIMATE CHANGE GOVERNMENT OF PAKISTAN THROUGH SINDH FOREST DEPARTMENT.

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) has initiated the distribution of fruit plants and community awareness workshops among the riverine communities of district Sukkur and Shaheed Benazirabad under the project , "Sustainable Forest Management in Pakistan.

Sustainable Forest Management in Pakistan is funded by Global Environment Facility (GEF) /UNDP and implemented by Ministry of Climate Change through provincial Forest Department which aims at promoting sustainable forest management in Pakistan and mitigation of climate change.

SRSO is conducting awareness workshops with communities to sensitize them regarding the Project and thereby helping them achieve sustainable livelihoods. They were educated how to plant varied types of fruit trees, and how to nurture them. Communities were made aware of the negative impact of deforestation, misuse of natural resources and the importance of environmental conservation and sustainability Communities are provided with saplings of fruits like Lemon, Jambul, jujube, Grewia asiatica(falsa) and Guava .

SRSO will identify households residing in the riverine belt(Kacha Area) and Sustainable Forest Management Project (SFM) & Forest Department will provide the fruit plants for Community(free of cost). Forest Department will ensure the availability of fruit plants as per requirement, in Sukkur, Qazi Ahmed & Sakrand in district SBA.

SRSO-Institute of Management and Skill Development (IMSD) is committed to enhance the development and management skills in order to create jobs and income generation opportunities especially for unemployed rural youth and women along with the capacity building of SRSO staff and community institutions (CIs). At present, it is implementing a Vocational Training Programme (VTP) for Sindh Government supported Peoples' Poverty Reduction Programme (PPRP) in 6 operating districts of Sindh. In this regard, it has initiated important training on nursery development and management especially of fruit trees for women in district Khairpur. The main purpose of the training is to train and enhance skills of rural women of formed Business Development Groups (BDG) members for operating a nursery plant to create income for their livelihood.

This training has been started on February 23, 2021, and 25 women of formed BDGs are attending from the Kot Diji, Thari Mir Waah, Kingri, and Khairpur talukas of district Khairpur. The training venue is at Bilawal Bhutto Public Khairpur. This training comprises 15 days of the extensive training program, which is covering all-important themes of nursery plant preparation, development, and management to marketing trees through the classroom to fieldwork sessions.

The Forest Department-Government of Sindh district Khairpur is supporting SRSO for this training and they have facilitated in training venue, identification and providing trainers and other necessary logistical and technical arrangements as well. The forest officials are visiting regularly the training and providing input and feedback for improving the training. District Forest Officer (DFO) Mr. Hosh Muhammad Shar has also visited and talked with participants regarding nursery development and ensured full support to women in establishing and managing nurseries. Meanwhile Mr. Ali Khan Mari, Mr. Talib Hussain, and Mr. Kaleemullah Aabasi (Foresters) of the Forest Department are the trainers of the training.

The key outcomes of the visit are; stems of Bananas from Khairpur will send to Faisalabad, SRSO will create the nursey and then will be discussed the community for growing it there, for it we will bring the scions/plants from Kot Momin, contacted with Green Circle owner Dr. Tasneem Khaliq and he is ready to give the authentic varieties of all kind of vegetable seeds at SRSO Sukkur for creating the KGs and agreement with Fiber and Tech Dept.

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) organized 2 workshops with Local Government Officials on the Sindh Senior Citizens Welfare Act 2014 under the Help Age International supported Promoting Rights of Older People P at Shikarpur and Jacobabad district March 30 and 31, 2021 respectively.

The key objectives of the workshop were; to sensitize the Secretaries Union Councils, and Municipal Committee Representatives regarding the Sindh Senior Citizens Welfare Act 2014. In addition to this, to comprehend the local Government representatives for the rights of older people. Further to make clears the government officials to pen down the challenges and issues as older people face tremendous problems especially in Old age.

In both workshops, Older People rights and issues were shared and discusses and they said the rights have been ignored and senior citizens are hardly respected in the context of solving older issues in the government departments. For this, there is a dire need to implement the Act effectively, sitting all government officials must write down to their concerned officers, and authorities to take serious actions could timely be taken in order to relief the older people.

At Shaikarpur 28 participants have taken part in the event from all talukas of district Shikarpur, Mr. Abdul Hanif Pitafi ADC-Mr. Abid Latif and I Chief Municipal Officer asked that we would tackle job with SRSO, older people association to the immediate

execution of The ACT. if SRSO provide the vulnerable list of Older people we will organize the restricted asset through an appropriate channel they asked we will write up to our department and District administration to add budget of older people being development schemes, in the end, they appreciated SRSO HelpAge's work.

Larkana & Shikarpur/March 2021

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) has achieved an important milestone of the installation/construction of Hand Washing Stations at main market places and schools in district Larkana under ECHO funded Covid-19 Project. Total targeted 101 stations have been constructed/installed successfully in both districts (51 Larkana and 51 Shikarpur), Thus, at 40 market places, 60 government schools (30 boys and 30 girls) and 2 district hospitals of all talukas of the Larkana and Shikarpur districts. SRSO has installed mobile hand wash stations at public/market places and constructed permanent hand wash stations in schools in order to develop and promote the best handwashing practices among the masses and children as well to further contain the spread of novel covid-19 virus. This is another important intervention of the project, which is supporting and facilitating the communities and masses to combat with COVID-19 pandemic. There is a target of 101 hand washing establishment in both districts. The Project Focal Person-SRSO said about this achievement, "this is happened with the support of all stakeholders to SRSO Team because these locations were identified by concerned departments as well concerned of schools EDO- Larkana provided a list of schools where enrollment is above 150 students and market locations by town and municipal committee. Meanwhile Deputy Commissioners were on board in the whole process and all facilitated and supported SRSO in the achieving this milestone" Now, they are also responsible to ensure its sustainability and taking care and safety as well and this purpose they have instructed and nominated the focal persons at markets and SMS in schools.

For the promotion of Agricultural Enterprises "Beekeeping training course" for 15 community members of taluka Gambat has been initiated by SRSO-Institute of Management and Skill Development (IMSD) under the Vocational Training Programme (VTP) component of GoS funded Peoples' Poverty Reduction Programme (PPRP). This training is being conducted with the technical assistance of Honeybee Research Institute (HBRI) and Pakistan Agricultural Research Council (PARC). Dr. Khalid Rafique (Scientific Officer-PARC Islamabad) is the lead-trainer along with two technical team members.

The training organized at village Mehboob Kalhoro in UC Razi Dero of Taluka Gambat and District Khairpur.

This is a one month training and will complete in two phases, each comprising of 15 days duration. In first phase Participants have learned all the basics required to be successful at beekeeping and second phase comprise of demonstration and practical work of beekeeping by trainees.

Beekeeping enterprise offers one of the best options for the rural communities to generate sustainable incomes because of its minimal requirements for land, machinery and equipment, labor and capital investment.
