**LAUNCHING CEREMONY OF EXPANDED PEOPLES' POVERTY REDUCTION PROGRAM**

**CHAIRMAN PAKISTAN PEOPLES' PARTY MR. BILAWAL BHUTTO ZARDARI AND SYED MURAD ALI SHAH CHIEF MINISTER SINDH WERE THE CHIEF GUESTS. ABOVE 4,000 ORGANIZED RURAL WOMEN ATTENDED THE CEREMONY GHOTKI/SEPTEMBER01, 2021**

The government of Sindh and Sindh Rural Support Organization jointly organized a launching ceremony of the Expanded Peoples' Poverty Reduction Program (PPRP) at Sports Complex Ghotki. Chairman Pakistan Peoples' Party Mr. Bilawal Bhutto Zardari and Syed Murad Ali Shah Chief Minister Sindh were the chief guests. Meanwhile, Mr. Nisar Ahmed Khurro President PPP-Sindh, National Assembly Members; Mr. Muhammad Bux Khan Mahar, Mr. Khalid Ahmed Khan Lund, Provincial Ministers; Syed Nasir Hussain Shah, Mr. Abdul Bari Pitafi, Mr. Jam Khan Shoro, Mr. Mukesh Chawala, Senator Jam Mahtab Khan Dahar, and MPA Mr. Shahyar Khan Shar have also attended the ceremony. The ceremony was attended by above 4,000 women leaders and activists of the Community Institutions (CO/VO/LSO) and program beneficiary's from the 13 SRSO outreach districts of Sindh mainly from expanded districts Ghotki and Sukkur. Secretary Planning, (P&DD-GoS) and Program Coordinator, PPRP-GoS, and other senior officials and media persons were also present at the event.

Pakistan People's Party (PPP) Chairman Mr. Bilawal Bhutto Zardari said on the occasion, "Sindh Government believes in serving people and he himself want to facilitate them without any discrimination. He added that "This is one of my most favorite Programmes of Sindh Government because that Peoples' Poverty Reduction Program would also empower the women economically, flourishing a woman would definitely change the entire living of the family." He said it was his dream to empower women, as her slain mother thought to do, saying the Sindh government has launched a program with Rs.6 billion funding to provide 23,000 houses to the deserving women of Sindh, especially of Ghotki and Sukkur districts.

Chief Minister Syed Murad Ali Shah said that the poverty alleviation program had been approved by [then prime minister] Ms. Benazir Bhutto and launched by [then Sindh chief minister] Syed Qaim Ali Shah. Now it was being extended to eight more districts. With the required funding expected to be received this Programme would be extended to all districts of the province. He further, said, "no doubt this is a silent revolution which is bringing positive changes in the lives of rural women through organizing, training, enterprise development and other initiatives to empower and reduce poverty."

Mr. Muhammad Dittal Kalhoro CEO-SRSO briefed about the SRSO, its outreach in Sindh, and key features of the PPRP. He said, "SRSO is implementing successfully this program since 2017 in 6 districts and now it has been expanded to both districts Ghotki and Sukkur. He further added, "SRSO thank I of Sindh Government for generous and continuous support to SRSO for empowering rural women and reducing the poverty in rural areas."

Mr. Nisar Ahmed Khuhro (President PPP-Sindh), Mr. Nasir Hussain Shah (Secretary Planning, P&DD-GoS), and Mr. Muhd Bux Khan Mahar (MNA) also addressed the event and appreciated the efforts of organized women of the community institutions and program beneficiaries. SRSO Education sector has initiated Intra-departmental Capacity Building Workshop Series for teachers and School Management staff of SAS-SRSO Managed Schools. The series of workshops is intended to empower teachers and education staff working in different capacities with the basic knowledge and skills for a better understanding of assigned tasks.

To achieve the purpose, a one-day capacity building workshop on lesson planning has been conducted by the SRSO Head Office Education Team at district Kandhkot - Kashmore, and Shikarpur on Sep 8th, 2021, and Sep 11th, 2021 respectively. A total of 28 participants (13 from district Kandhkot - Kashmore and 15 from district Shikarpur) including District project officers of both districts, Education Promoters, Headteachers, and School coordinators of community cluster schools have attended the workshops. The workshop is designed based on the professional needs of staff and areas of their improvement. Before the design and development of workshop contents and resources, teachers' lesson plans have been thoroughly reviewed so that the workshop may cater to the needs of the education staff.

The workshop was organized using activity-based techniques. Participants were engaged in multiple peer and individual activities including brainstorming activities, elicitation, Think, Pair and Share activity, constructive discussion, demonstration, and interactive lectures. To capture the interest of the participants and to know the effectiveness of the workshop, participants were engaged in Pre - Assessment, and Post - Assessment activities.

A detailed discussion has been carried out on the process of developing an effective teaching lesson plan where writing tips of each and every section of the prescribed lesson plan format (developed at Head office, Sukkur) has been discussed with the help of practical example and explanation. Participants were made engaged in hands-on practice activities by the workshop facilitator Shabana Mansoor (Manager Education).

### SHIKARPUR /SEPTEMBER24, 2021

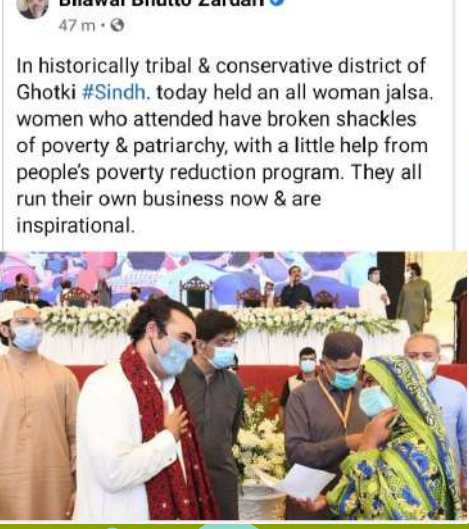
