Delegation of The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) and Poverty Alleviation and Inclusive Development Across Rural Sindh (PAIDAR) Program along with Sindh Government officials visited SRSO in district Thatta. Assistant Deputy Commissioner-01 Of Thatta Mr Riaz Hussain Laghari also joined the delegation. Hystra Paris Delegation visits SRSO

A team from Hystra Paris Ms. Laura Farisini, Mr. Guillaume Massot, and Mr. Bashir Anjum visited the BEP (Pakistan Rural Market Test project) in district Kamber-Shahdadkot. The main purpose of the visit was to observe WELLMA sachet storage, dispatching, record, and utilization mechanisms for PLWs. On the first day, they visited the warehouse and checked the procedure of dispatching of WELLMA sachet to the CRPs they checked order copies of Senior CRPs and the hard copies of delivery challans and asked about order preparation, also observe the current situation of stock and warehouse. Ms. Aisha Tariq RSPN Project Manager BEP briefed them about proper fillings of delivery challans and all activities of the warehouse.

On the 2nd day, delegation members visited two project clusters Shaikh Farm and Bahar Malano where they held VO meetings, observed the record of CRPs, and conducted interviews with PLWs and CBOs as well. In the VO meetings and interviews with PLWs and CBOs at Bahar Malano where they put some technical questions from the community about WELLMA. Team also visited the Historical place Indus of civilization Mohen jo Daro. DM-SRSO and DPO BEP SRSO facilitated and briefed them in visit.

Hystra Paris team appreciated the proper SRSO mechanism of the warehouse and its distribution of products to targeted beneficiaries at the grassroots level. Hystra Paris is one of the Technical Partner Organization of BEP (Pakistan Rural Market Test Project) funded by BILL & MELINDA GATES Foundation and which is currently implemented by Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) in partnership with Rural Support Programmes Network (RSPN) in district Kamber-Shahdadkot The main purpose of the project is to increase the availability of nutritious, protein-rich foods to the poorest population.



3-Day COMBO Training on Malaria Case Management, Malaria Information System/Software & the usage of RDT kits for Health Care Providers

Larkana/ July 26, 27 & 28, 2022

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) organized 3-day COMBO Training on Malaria Case Management, Malaria Information System/Software, and usage of RDT kits for Health Care Providers under GFATM Malaria Project at Larkana. Mr. Sultan Ahmed (District Coordinator-GFATM-SRSO) welcomed and briefed the participants about the project and its progress in the district.

The training was formally started by Dr. Saleem Akhtar Shaikh (Deputy DHO DHIS/MIS & Master Trainer), Mr. Ali Asghar Shaikh District Malaria Superintendents VBD. Dr. Sakhirullah Pathan Deputy DHO VBD's Larkana shared the objective of training and said 3Days training sessions specially arranged for Medical Officers/Senior Medical Officers of Primary & Secondary Care Hospitals on Un-complicated Malaria Case Management, Malaria Information System/Software (MIS) & Usage of RDT Kits.

Training methodology was used in order to acquire the knowledge and skills on training course various techniques for training were used to involve participants in learning through Multimedia/Projector, Flips charts and also exercises and scenarios were provided to stimulate learning by doing.

At the end of the training, ceremony was organized for awarding the certificates to the participants. Dr. Syed Athar Hussain Shah District Health Officer & Mr. Abdul Raheem Junejo District Manager PPHI Secondary Care invited by the SSR, the distinguished graced the occasion. Dr. Sakhirullah Pathan Deputy DHO VBD's, Mr. Ram Kirshan PC NRSP, and Ms. Murk Ayaz Training Officer NRSP also attended the ceremony. Meanwhile from SRSO Ms. Saima Karim, Mr. Sultan Ahmed & Mr. Majid Ali also attended the ceremony.

At present, SRSO is implementing GFATM Malaria Project in partnership with the National Rural Support Programme (NRSP) in the Larkana and Kamber-Shahdadkot districts. The goal of the project is to reduce of malaria burden by 20% in 60 endemic districts by 2023. Meanwhile, the specific objectives of the project are: i) ensure and sustain universal coverage of multi prevention services to populations at risk in targeted districts, ii) ensure and sustain 80% coverage of quality assured early diagnosis, prompt treatment services to the population at risk in targeted districts, iii) increase community awareness up to 80% on the benefits of early diagnosis, prompt treatment and malaria preventive measures using health promotion, advocacy, and BCC interventions, and iv) ensure availability of quality-assured strategic information for informed decision making.

The delegation of Action Against Hunger (ACF) led by Ms. Rachel Alessandri -Regional Director Operation Asia Pool- ACF along with Mr. Zulfiqar Mithani (Deputy Country Director- ACF) and Cesvi partners visited SRSO interventions under the project Strengthening Resilience of Populations Vulnerable to Recurrent Disasters and Emergencies in Sindh funded by European Civil Protection and Humanitarian aid Operations (ECHO) in district Thatta.

The team visited in Village Yousif Shoro of UC Chilya in taluka and district Thatta and conducted meetings with Community/ beneficiaries regarding disasters, project interventions and impacts to combat disasters/emergencies at the grassroots level. Mr. Ghulam Rasool Samejo (Regional General Manager-SRSO), Project Coordinator and District Manager facilitated the visit.

LSO Leaders shared the key initiatives taken by communities under this project and its impact at the community level being living in disaster-prone areas. The CIs leaders were trained for recurrent disasters, therefore they shared their learning and impact-based lessons at the community level for strengthening the disaster risk reduction. The CIs leaders also discussed the planning for the current monsoon. VDMC Leaders shared with the delegation that in village Yousif Shoro 17 houses were damaged ,17 livestock died, 13 people were injured and one person died in recent thunderstorm with heavy rain.

ACF team assured to initiate the Rapid Assessment Survey of Monsoon 2022 Damages and losses at the village level and review the strategy of the project to combat disasters and its outcomes at the community and district levels.



40 Productive Assets handed over to Ultra-Poor House Holds

Productive assets of heifers were handed over to 40 ultra-poor families of different union councils of the district Shikarpur in order to graduate poverty line on a sustainable basis. For this purpose, on July 26, 2022, a distribution ceremony was organized at Shikarpur and Mr. Rustal Ali Soomro (Regional General Manager-SRSO) and Mr. Naveed Ishaque (Sr. Manager MER) attended the ceremony, supervised the process, distributed assets, and talked with selected beneficiaries. On this occasion, MER Team and DM-Shikarpur briefed the beneficiaries about the programme, complaints referral system and livestock insurance policy, and death claim. Furthermore, they emphasized the care and increase of received assets for their livelihood support. All heifers have been vaccinated, tagged, and insured as well by SRSO.

At present SRSO is implementing National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP) with the support of the Government of Pakistan and The International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), in Shikarpur and Kashmore@Kandhkot districts. The overall goal of the Programme is to assist the ultra-poor and very poor in graduating out of poverty on a sustainable basis, simultaneously improving their overall food security, nutritional status, and resilience to climate change.

The overall objective of the program is to sustainably improve the nutritional status of children under five and pregnant and lactating women (PLWs) in Sindh corresponding to the second target indicator of the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG).
