The government of Sindh and Sindh Rural Support Organization jointly organized a launching ceremony of the Expanded Peoples' Poverty Reduction Program (PPRP) at Sports Complex Ghotki. Chairman Pakistan Peoples' Party Mr. Bilawal Bhutto Zardari and Syed Murad Ali Shah Chief Minister Sindh were the chief guests. Pakistan People's Party (PPP) Chairman Mr. Bilawal Bhutto Zardari said on the occasion, "Sindh Government believes in serving people and he himself want to facilitate them without any discrimination. He added that "This is one of my most favorite Programmes of Sindh Government because that Peoples' Poverty Reduction Program would also empower the women economically, flourishing a woman would definitely change the entire living of the family." SRSO Education sector has initiated Intra-departmental Capacity Building Workshop Series for teachers and School Management staff of SAS-SRSO Managed Schools. The series of workshops is intended to empower teachers and education staff working in different capacities with the basic knowledge and skills for a better understanding of assigned tasks.

To achieve the purpose, a one-day capacity building workshop on lesson planning has been conducted by the SRSO Head Office Education Team at district Kandhkot - Kashmore, and Shikarpur on Sep 8th, 2021, and Sep 11th, 2021 respectively. A total of 28 participants (13 from district Kandhkot - Kashmore and 15 from district Shikarpur) including District project officers of both districts, Education Promoters, Headteachers, and School coordinators of community cluster schools have attended the workshops. The workshop is designed based on the professional needs of staff and areas of their improvement. He further added that it is mandatory to be registered without which no funding could be transferred by and donor if an organization is unregistered. In addition to this, Pre & Post Assessment was also taken from the members to know the opinion and perceptions of the older people related to the Charity & Regulation Act.
