A mission of the International Fund for Agriculture Development (IFAD) led by Mr. Boirard Hubert Country Director for Pakistan visited National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP)-Govt. of Pakistan implemented by Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) in partnership with Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund (PPAF). Mr. Rub Nawaz (IFAD), Abdul Rahim (IFAD), and Ms. Samia Liaquat Ali, Muhammad Fazil, and Sajid Ali from PPAF were part of the mission

For this purpose, an event was organized to meet and conduct dialogue with NPGP beneficiaries at village Ghulam Qadir Khokhar UC Kashmore Colony 1. The dialogue was attended by productive assets, interest-free loans, and trained CRPs and participated in this interactive dialogue with mission members.

A detailed, interactive, and participatory dialogue and discussion with beneficiaries of the NPGP/Ehsaas Aamdan. All relevant questions and queries came under discussion with participants regarding program impacts and best learning on their lives and livelihood. Before starting a dialogue, Village Organization representatives presented village and VO profiles and shared the process of beneficiary selection, planning, distributions, and follow-up. Then, all present 25 productive assets, 12 IFL beneficiaries, and 04-trained master trainers CRPs shared their stories.



Productive assets beneficiaries of livestock, juice machine, Koriyama, and mobile shops shared their stories and getting beneficiaries and its impacts as well. Thus, IFL beneficiaries tolled about their received loan, its utilization, recovery, and plan for expanding their initiated enterprises. Most of the women received 40 to 45 thousand and invested in livestock, cloth shops, and kryiana shops as well. Finally, CRP who have been trained as master trainers on enterprise development under the NPGP. 4 CRPs shared their learning of training and its replication and contents and challenges during attending and replication the training to NPGP beneficiaries.

They were all impressive stories and shared their success journey from extreme poverty to alleviating poverty on a sustainable basis through initiating business and income generation activities, which is happened through the support of NPGP/Ehsaas Aamdan.

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) in partnership with ACF under SIDA-funded Building Resilient Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) in partnership with ACF organized a one-day orientation workshop on LOCUST TOOLKIT under SIDA-funded Building Resilient Communities by Connecting and Emergency Response to Sustainable Development Project at Plant and Protection Department Sindh Agriculture University Tando Jam. Total 30 new agriculture workers/activists attended the workshop and were trained in order to roll out the same sessions with farmers on Toolkit in three districts. These 30 agriculture workers/activists have been identified and selected from the targeted 30 disaster-prone-Union Councils of the Mirpurkhas, Badin, and Thatto.

Dr. Imran Khatri (Head of Department-Entomology) and Dr. Sarfraz Rajpart (Ph.D. on Locust) facilitated the workshop. They discussed in detail the history of locust, their types, impacts, effective control methods, and use of tool kit with participants. For this purpose, a comprehensive Tool Kit on Locust in the Sindhi language has been also developed by Sindh Agriculture University under this project. Each trained agriculture worker/activist will conduct 10 rollout sessions in a month with farmers from December 2021.

The delegation also paid a visit to view the small-scale business run by Cls leaders under BDG- Chess Making, Traui Pattar making products, Small Scale Nursery (forest trees, fruit trees, shadow trees, and herbal plants also).



They visited each Low-Cost Houses and tree planted in their corridors.

The Cls leaders presented the Sindhi tradition of Ajrak and warmly welcomed the guests with a welcome note by the LSO chairperson. The Local support Organization leaders shared the LSO journey with program details of activities carried under their platform at the Household Level, mainly focused on how much these interventions have impacted each household. The main activity of presentation was demographics and geographic information and self-initiative: mobilization for following CoVid-19 SoPs, identification of suspected cases, opened a closed school, CNIC development by calling Nadra Van, Mosquito fumigation spray in all UC level villages, livestock vaccination, and vaccination of children, LPW, each male and female Covid 19, etc.

In last, the delegation held a detailed discussion with these women about their journey and how they faced challenges to empower themselves.
