Chief Executive Officer Muhammad Dittal Kalhoro inaugurated on Friday a first incubation Management training under Enterprise Development Program specialized for entrepreneurship. Institute of Management and Skills Development a training Wing of SRSO is hosting the training in collaboration with IdeaGist. The CEO and a team of IdeaGist, SRSO GoS Technical Advisor, CEO SRSO, Team Leader PPRP, IMSD Senior Manager, District Managers, ED Districts Teams, and Head Office employees attended the training.



In his opening remarks, the CEO said that "learning is a lifelong process and the journey of acquiring knowledge ends only with the end of one's life." Addressing training Participants, he said, "Investing in you is an investment in SRSO for incubation of Ideas that supports hundreds of thousands of households who are the future of Sindh for uplifting their living standard."

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) has initiated an important activity of DRR Kit distribution among the LSOs under the SIDA-ACF-funded Building Resilient Communities by Connecting and Emergency Response to Sustainable Development Project in 03 targeted districts including Thatta. The distribution of tool kits started on January 5, 2022, and ended on January 19, 2022, in the district.10 Union Councils from the disaster-prone areas of the district have been selected for project interventions, These union councils are including Faquer Jo Goth, Tando Hafiz Shah, Jhangri, Soof Shoro, Bijora, Juna, Jhampir, Kohistan Dubo, and Kakrand.

These DRR Tool Kits comprised of 40 wheelbarrows, 20 Ropes, 80 Search Lights, 50 Whistles, 80 Spades, 20 Mega Phones, and 10 Leather Bags which have been distributed in District Thatta. These DRR tool kits have been distributed in order to facilitate disaster-affected communities to combat disaster by their affective usage. These DRR tool kits will help them to reduce their suffering and help them to come out of emergencies. These DRR tool kits will be placed at LSO offices so that entire villages of particular union councils can use these items to come out of emergency and disaster, DRR tool kits will support them to reduce their losses. Before distribution kit briefing session was conducted with LSO and targeted Village Organizations of 5 villages in each UC and SRSO-SIDA Project team briefed LSO and VOs leaders about the kit, its proper use, and safety during in case of emergency. These ceremonies were also attended by the Project Manager, District Manager, and District Team Leader and surprised the whole process.



JICA LIGHT-F PROJECT

A Dialogue was conducted with Ehsaas-Interest Free Loan Beneficiaries of Most Deprived Baaghari Community

Shikarpur/January 14, 2022



Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) district Shikarpur conducted a dialogue with selected 35 beneficiaries of Ehsaas-Interest Free Loan (INFL) from the most deprived Baaghri community at village Chak Baaghri Mohalla Taluka Lakhi. These beneficiaries have been selected to support their existing business in order to improve their economic conditions. These 35 women are running their business successfully at a small scale and this support will help them in scaling up their business. Mr. Zaheer Ahmed Shar District Manager-SRSO Shikarpur conducted the dialogue. He briefed in detail about SRSO, Ehsaas-IFL, and its recovery process.

After that scheme of lift irrigation at VO Channa, UC Mad Bahu was visited by him, where VO leaders briefed operational and maintenance procedures and benefits of the lift irrigation CPI scheme.

The project aim is to improve the livelihood of Female Home-based workers and their families through Life Skill Management, Income Generation, and Financial Access.









Peoples' Poverty Reduction Program-Govt. of Sindh

3rd January 2022 | PPRP-GoS | Sukkur | Digital payment to BNFs | CMST certified Pax | Mobilink/Jazz Cash

Under PPRP program SRSO successfully initiated the digital Payment System to BNFs at Taluka Pano Aqil of Sukkur District. These BNFS have got three days of training and they got their payment as per their Attendance record and verification from NADRA.

The CDP-Cash Disbursement Point was arranged on two locations of Pano Aqil where 158 BNFs were intimated for Payment through CNIC and M-Wallet by biometric verification along with online NADRA verification.

In pursuance of 110 BNFs were present and got the payment successfully, mostly the CNIC based BNFs got their payments, M-wallet BNFs were unable to provide the actual SIM and CNIC, therefore, their payment did not proceed but who have bring both successfully cash out the payment through M-wallet.

There were proper arrangements were made at CDP. Likewise;

1- Information and Registration Desk, 2- MIS verification through MIS record, 3- Jazz Portal Name, CNIC and Payment verification by issuing the Transaction IF to be entered in Jazz agent device against the BNF CNIC., 4- Biometric / Thumb Inserting on the device by female S.O on jazz agent and if any female found an issue in the thumb, we have brought all remedial solution i.e. Onion rubbing on the thumb, Lemon rubbing and last Special Gel/sanitizers and 5- Cash receiving and the CNIC basis BNFs also got a new sim and opened M-Wallet account.

During disbursement, there were few neutral persons and journalists were also come to check the transparency and the payment deduction and found it satisfactory.

The SRSO Head Office Team, IMSD, and District Manager along with her team were presented their services and made this possible. The community applauded the SRSO efforts to not go to the bank for payments nor to agents who deduct or do frauds in payments. M-wallet BNFs share their usage of accounts and feel economically empowered that they are going by themselves to shops for cash-out of payment.

The sessions were held on Demographics Transition & Population, the role of local government in the implementation of Act, what local government can do for senior citizens during COVID-19 pandemic, what local government can do in development schemes for senior citizens, what local government can do for senior citizens at health facilities, and what local government can do for entertainment of senior citizens.

SRSO-Social Service Sector (SSS) Team briefed about ongoing SRSO interventions in education for increasing access to the right to education of rural children in partnership with Sindh Education Foundation (SEF)-Govt. of Sindh and USAID-EMO schools in Shikarpur, Kashmore@Kandhkot, Sukkur, and Khairpur districts. They told that "SRSO is working for formal, non-formal and adult literacy fields in the education sector with active community participation through engaging Community Institutions (CO, VO, and LSO) and Education and Literacy Department-Govt. of Sindh."

The meeting was attended by all key sector heads of SRSO. Delegation members also visited different parts of the SRSO complex. CEO-SRSO provided SRSO Publications to delegation members.





JICA LIGHT-F Project with the support of SRSO and Women Development Department-Govt. of Sindh conducted a one-day ToT on Financial Literacy for leaders and sub-leaders of 10 Business Development Groups (BDGs) in January 04, 2022 at SRSO Complex Sukkur. 22 participants took part in that training and came from the BDGs of Sukkur, Khairpur and Shikarpur districts.

These main topics were covered during the ToT i) Digital humarmandi, ii) How to improve financial capability? Iii) Budgeting, iv) importance of saving and v) financial institutions

NADRA CNIC REGISTRATION CAMP FOR ARTISAN WOMEN OF BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT GROUPS

Before organizing the registration camp, CED **Team also conducted** community mobilization meetings with rural artisan members of 2 **BDGs of Langah and** discussed and motivated community and BDGs members for registration. **SRSO District Khairpur Team coordinated with** NDRA district office and motivated them to provide NADRA registration van for these rural women. This camp was facilitated and managed successfully by Ms. Bakhtawar Mahar (Program Officer-CED Head Office) and Ms. **Rubina Baloch (Unit** Incharge-SRSO Khairpur).



Its a fact that CNIC registration, getting, and renewing is a challenge for rural women, especially due to social taboos and constraints in access to NADRA facilitation services. Therefore, during the meetings with SRSO fostered Village Organizations (VOs) and Business Development Groups (BDGs) women raised this issue and requested SRSO to support them in this process. In response, SRSO-Crafts Enterprise Development (CED) Head Office Sukkur team planned and organized CNIC Registration Camp with the help of SRSO District Khairpur for artisan women. This camp was organized for two Business Development Groups Langha at village Pir Mangyoon Taluka and District Khairpur. The main purpose of the organizing camp was to facilitate artisan women of the SRSO formed Business Development Groups (BDGs) in CNIC registration. Total 54 artisan women and community members were registered by NADRA during the mobile registration service. CED is supporting and facilitating the rural artisan women to capacitate and increase their access to different services, resources, skills, and institutions as well to empower them socially and economically.

SRSO with the collaboration of ACF organized Three days Training of Trainers on "Community-based disaster risk management" in District Thatta, from 25 to 27 January- 2022.

10 Females, 10 Male Community Resource Persons and 2 Female LSO Coordinators attended the training.

The facilitators delivered detailed and interactive sessions on community-based disaster risk assessment, review of data collection, integrating risk information into socio-economic development planning, Early warning system, concepts & definitions of Hazard & Risk and gender mainstreaming in CBDRM.

The training focused on different key aspects of disaster risk management including Prevention Preparedness Paradigm, Hazards. Disaster Development, and Mainstreaming of Disaster Risk Reduction, Role of Community in Disaster Preparedness, Climate Change and its Consequences on hazards. It was discussed that coastal communities of Sindh are at the forefront of the impacts of climate-related hazards and vulnerable communities are likely victims of disasters yet they are the first responders in the event of a calamity adding that the awareness of communities about disasters as well as their management is highly imperative to mitigate the impact of disaster risks. The training concluded with the certificates to the participants on the final day of the training session.

Under ECHO-9 Project 100 CRPs and 10 LSO coordinators will be trained from the targeted union councils of district Thatta.




