### MOU SIGNING AND LAUNCHING CEREMONY OF DIGITAL SKILL COURSE FOR RURAL YOUTH UNDER NPGP-GOP BETWEEN SRSO AND SUKKUR IBA UNIVERSITY SUKKUR IBA UNIVERSITY/NOVEMBER09,2022

SRSO is distributing productive assets under the National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP) funded by IFAD and GOP to the rural Communities of Shikarpur and Khamore@Kandhkot since 2021, with assets of livestock (heifers) and other than livestock, including grocery stores, loader bikes, rickshaws, chingchi, vehicles, sewing machines with items, plumbing, electrician, welding, etc. Under the training component of the programme different capacity-building trainings i.e. enterprise development, climate change, and DRR, gender, health, WASH, and Nutrition, etc. of beneficiaries have been also initiated through engaging and training of Community Resource Persons (CRPs) as master trainers. Now, in this year 2022, In the era of digitization and e-commerce, SRSO has taken a landmark initiative in digital skills for rural youth from one of Pakistan's leading universities, Sukkur IBA University. The first batch of 46 community youth and digital heroes from remote areas of Shikarpur and Kahsmore@Kandhkot has been enrolled for this training.

Memorandum of Understanding(MOU) signing and Launching Ceremony of Digital Skill Course for Rural Youth under the National Poverty Graduation Programme (NPGP) held on 9 November 2022, between Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) and Sukkur-Institute of Business Administration University (SIBAU).

### Digital Marketing Course-Follow up Session with Artisan under JICA's Light F-Project

### 21 trainees of online-course from SRSO formed and supported Business Development Groups (BDGs) attended the session at

SRSO- Craft Enterprise Development Sector-CED organized follow-up sessions with the artisan of Business Development Groups Digital of On-line Digital Marketing Course on October 31 and November 01, 2022.

21 trainees of the online digital marketing course attended the district follow ups sessions from SRSO formed and under JICA-supported BDGs of Khairpur, Sukkur, Ghotki, and Larkana Districts. The main objective of the follow-up sessions was to provide direct in-house training on improving soft skills to digitize the crafts of the artisan.

SRSO under JICA's Light-F Project started an online course for projecttargeted BDGs of 04 districts intending to enhance soft skills to digitalize their business by increasing their access and market linkages. This course started in February 2022. It was comprised of two parts one basic and 2nd advance. During direct follow-up sessions artisan women have been oriented and trained on key live course modules i.e. WhatsApp business (maintaining the broadcast list, updating status, completing the catalog, blocking someone, and adding new contact), Facebook Account and Facebook Marketplace (verifying account and updating Facebook marketplace, selling products), Facebook page and messenger (posting products, status, writing captions, answering comments, dealing customers on messengers), Instagram Business (updating photos, status, using different features of status, writing a caption, and answering comments) and, Photography and online Posting (photography skills with available resources, showing them examples from existing brands, the frequency required to post online and captions).

Participant artisan learned about these topics through practice and question and answering. Now all participants have their own Gmail ids, mobile wallet accounts, Facebook pages, Instagram business accounts, WhatsApp business accounts, photography, and Canva. They all are promoting and market their specific products by using these digital platforms. Under the JICA's Light F-Project, artisan women have been trained and facilitated to start their businesses on digital and e-businesses. The artisan women are expanding their e-business through digital marketing, These sessions were facilitated by Ms. Rabab Fatima, a Digital Course **Trainer and Financing** Learning Specialist of the JICA-Light F-Project. She is a software engineer and has 4 years of experience in digital marketing training and facilitation. Meanwhile, Mr.



### PROGRAMME IMPROVEMENT FOR NUITRITION IN SINDH (PINS-ER-III) SHIKARPUR, LARKANA & KAMBER-SHADADKOT

Shikarpur/ November21, 2022 To mitigate the disastrous impacts of floods in Sindh, the EU announced Early Recovery packages to support small scale subsistence farmers to cultivate bio-fortified wheat to address micro-nutrient deficiencies. In collaboration with RSPN, SRSO distributed seeds of bio-fortified wheat to 305 female farmers of Shikarpur under the Program for Improved Nutrition in Sindh (ER-III).


In 2021, under the programme it was successfully experienced the cultivation of zinc-fortified wheat with a high yield (09 maunds more than average). The EU is supporting the Government of Sindh to address malnutrition and stunting through the Programme for Improved Nutrition in Sindh (PINS ER-3) to sustainably improve the nutritional status of women and children in rural Sindh.

**Kamber-Shahdadkot/November23,2022** Food insecurity rises after the rain and flood, the community's major part of livelihood is based on agriculture which is badly affected postcalamity, Early recovery packages were distributed among the affected community in the form of wheat seeds to 260 female farmers and 260 biozate max PGR for 260 acres, at Nasirabad taluka under PINS ER III (Programm for improved nutrient) funded by European Union with the collaboration of RSPN. This will address the issue of food insecurity among the community.

Sindh Rural Support Organization District Shikarpur on dated Olst Nov, 2022 under PINS ER-3 distributed Poultry inputs (9 Hen + 1 Cockrel and 1 Feed bag) among 62 Community Poultry Entrepreneur at LSO Mehran, Iqra and Benazir Taluka Lakhi and Khanpur, where the team discussed regarding benefits and importance of CPE.
