SRSO Highlights of Two Quarters (Oct-2012-March2013)

- Muhammad Hanif Channa joined SRSO as a Chief Executive Officer (CEO); qualified from Harvard University & International University of Japan. He is an icon of humanitarian organizations and different NGO's. He served as a Civil Servant-Government of Sindh.
- Capacity Building of Local Support Organizations is very essential for smooth running of routine activities keeping
 in view 600 LSO members from district Shikarpur, Jacobabad and Kashmore-Kandhkot were trained in Managerial
 skills, Book keeping, CIF appraisals and monitoring trainings.
- SRSO-Women Craft Groups participated in the exposure visit "Exhibition and Market Survey for Women Crafts" at Karachi. Exhibition organized by Indus Earth Organization in which SRSO eleven master trainers trained in variety of quilting crafts.
- The Directors of Sindh Growth Rural and Revitalization Programme, visited LSO Sindh Surhan Annual Anniversary
 at district Shikarpur, where LSO Sindh Surhan Chairperson Bhag Bhari and other community women shared the
 challenges, experiences, and lesson learnt through speeches.
- On October 18, 2012: The Delegation from ASF-USAID visited LSO Awaz at District Shikarpur. Delegation conducted meeting with Agriculture Groups and conducted dialogue with 24 LSO members.
- Under the tripartite partnership between Pakistan Petroleum Limited (PPL), Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund (PPAF) and SRSO, CPI project has been initiated for a period of 2 years to carry out 120 CPI Schemes at district Kashmore-Kandhkot.
- Ms. Naheed Shah visited LSO Wada Machyoon at District Khairpur, where she inaugurated date processing plant, met with LSO community members, asked for the plant processing and paid homage for productive efforts from community and SRSO.
- On December 31st, Sindh Rural Support Organization and HelpAge International jointly organized a workshop titled "Media Sensitization on Social Protection for Senior Citizens" at Press Club Shikarpur. The workshop purpose was to spread the awareness regarding the rights of senior citizens and to resolve their health and financial problems.
- SRSO-Gender Advocacy and Development Section (GAD) organized the "International Human Rights Day" at Sachal Auditorium Khairpur. Event highlighted the protection of human rights especially rural women. Event was attended by additional DC Khairpur, SRSO Management, lawyers, journalists, religious scholars and above all 400 SRSO women community members from khairpur and Shikarpur.
- M&E section conducted a monitoring study of BISP Waseela-e- Haq beneficiaries, who had started their own business, after receiving first installment. The activity was funded by PPAF. Study conducted at Naushahro Feroze, Khairpur, Sukkur, Ghotki, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Larkana and Kashmore@Kandhkot and Monitored 341 beneficiaries.
- SRSO Gender Advocacy and Development Section organized international women Day at Rohri to commemorate women internationally and tribute them with honor and integrity.
- NRM-Sector conducted community orientation workshop at UC Shadi Shaheed, District Khairpur, in which CO, VO and LSO members were oriented on the methods of irrigation, proper water supply, adequate fertilizers, plant protection measures, and harvesting methods to get maximum production from the crops.
- World craft council organized Craft exhibition in Chennai India. 40 participants from different countries participated and displayed their products representing the respective countries. From SRSO one member participated through SABAH Pakistan and displayed local products that captured the attention of the audience at zest.
