### **SUCCESS Programme**

The participation of SRSO-SUCCESS team members in various activities carried out by field teams in Larkana and Qamber Shahdadkot has been instrumental in achieving the programme objectives.

Field teams are being fully facilitated during the Programme Introduction sessions, CO formation and during the CMSTs, so that they are able to perform routine tasks efficiently while keeping the set standards, well defined in the SUCCESS Programme Implementation Manual (PIM).



SRSO, under the European Union funded SUCCESS programme, organised certificates awarding ceremonies during seven CMSTs in district Larkana. Prior to the ceremonies, formal interaction was made and feedback of the trained CO office bearers was also obtained to determine the effectiveness of the training sessions. The CMST events were found up to the mark in terms of training conduct, delivery and the understanding of trainees on sundry topics duly covered throughout three days. The feedback of all trainees was highly admirable; they were confident and zealous to initiate the work from the platform of their institutions. The PIU team, including Mr. Muzaffar Hussain (Manager-M&E), Mr. Sikander Sanam (Project Engineer), Mr. Asif Munir (Manager-Finance) and Ms. Samina Barkat Ali (Training Coordinator), participated in different CMSTs and distributed the participation certificates among the trained members.


### **PSC-PPM (Progress Planning and Review) Meeting**

### Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey Sindh-2014 reveales at SRSO complex

A Seminar to disseminate the final report of Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey Sindh-2014, organized by Government of Sindh Bureau of Statistics, Planning and Development Department, and UNICEF held at Sindh Rural Support Organization Complex Sukkur.

Director Sukkur IBA Mr. Nisar Ahmed Siddiqui and Deputy Commissioner (DC) Sukkur Dr Waheed Asghar Bhatti, Pro- Vice Chancellor, Shah Abdul Latif University (SALU) Khairpur, Dr Noor Ahmed Shaikh and Field Officer UNICEF Sindh, Ms Nagiza Khodjeava were the guests of honor.

On the occasion, report of Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey was presented which is based on data collected during February of August 2014. More than 19000 households were covered and Sindh MICS covers 125 socio-economic indicators.

The Report has socio-economic indicator disaggregated on rural and urban areas, gender wise, educational levels and wealth quin tiles and on geographical level like province, divisions and districts focusing the situation children and women in Sindh.

The survey was inducted by the Bureau of Statistics in collaboration with UNICEF, the Pakistan Council of Research Water Resources.

The report revealed that 15 percent of the children are thin for their height and one percent of children are overweight or too heavy in their height.

According to report, every 100 boys attending primary schools, 86 girls are also attending at the same time whereas 81 girls for every 100 boys are attending secondary schools. Around 29.1 percent of births of children less than five years of age are registered. Over 26 percent of the children aged between five and 17 years are involved in labor

### Field visit of PSC Validation of Low Coverage Union Councils by RSPN Staff-SUCCESS Programme

Under the SUCCESS Programme funded by EU (European Union), a field visit was undertaken to SRSO Head Office in Sukkur, and District Larkana. After the identification of low coverage UC's 14 were identified in District Larkana and Kambar Shadad Kot(8 in Larkana, 6 in Kambar Shahdadkot).

A meeting was held with the PSC Coordinator, Sona Khan, Manager M&E SUCCESS, Muzzaffar Panhwar, Manager M&E, Naveed Memon, MIS Officer, Farhad Ali and two key field/district supervisors at the SRSO Complex. Sona Khan provided an overview of the coverage in the completed UC's, including details about entire settlements that have migrated, refusal households, and settlements not found.
