Background

Sindh is Known for having a population of over 25 million people. Sindh can be called the most populated province of Pakistan. As far as its literacy rates are concerned, they are below 50 percent in rural areas. Karachi is leading the race and the rest are not even on the second or third position. Hyderabad, Mirpur Khas, Larkana and Jamshoro are a few other cities that can see a reasonable amount of literacy rate. On the whole, many children are deprived of education due to which a greater percentage of child labor can also be witnessed. The situation is more worsed in interior sindh. There is no better moment to realize education's role in helping households escape poverty than today. To unlock the wider benefits of education so that it can play its full part in helping the targeted communities achieve poverty eradication, all children need the chance to complete not only primary school but also lower secondary school. And access to schooling is not enough on its own. Education needs to be of good quality so that children actually learn. Given this fundamental role that a quality, equitable education can play in tackling the root causes of poverty.

In this Context the Directorate of literacy and Non Formal Basic Education working under the education and literacy department of Govt of Sindh is responsible for programmes on literacy and non formal education in Sindh. The department has tried to develop a sindh literacy Plan 2010-2015 with a vision of literate, educated and prosperous sindh province.

Introduction:

The USAID is a development partner to the Government of Sindh and is currently supporting the Department of Education and Literacy with implementation of the Sindh Basic Education Program (SBEP) in the targeted areas. The overarching goal of SBEP is "Increased and Sustained Student Enrollment in Primary, Middle and Secondary Schools in targeted geographical locations in Sindh". The Sindh Reading Program (SRP), funded by USAID and implemented by Chemonics International, is a five-year initiative working in the same geographic areas as the parent SBEP. SRP will support the SBEP goal based on lessons learned from USAID and the Government of Sindh's legacy of early grade teaching and learning.

Over the life of project, SRP aims to:

- •Improve teacher competencies for effective early grade reading and mathematics instruction (Component 1);
- •Improve early grade reading and mathematics assessment practices (Component 2);
- •Improve student access to supplementary reading and mathematics materials (Component 3)
- •Enhance participation of parents and caregivers in support of early grade literacy and numeracy for out of school children (Component 4).

With more than four million children in Sindh out of school and largely illiterate, SRP, with USAID funding, recognizes the need to direct resources towards critical Non-Formal Educational (NFE) opportunities under Component 4 of the project. These opportunities will complement the project's early grade reading interventions in formal schools.

Sindh Rural Support Organization:

SRSO's Vision:

The Vision of SRSO is to foster a framework of grassroots institutions in villages located in 425 Union Councils of 9 Districts in Sindh, to harness the potential lying within the communities to help themselves.

SRSO works to release the potential abilities, skills, and knowledge of rural men and women, to enable them to articulate their aspirations and to effectively marshal the resources they need to meet their identified needs. The purpose is poverty alleviation - enabling people to break the cycle of poverty, which begins with alack of opportunity, extends to the well-known miseries of

economic and nutritional poverty and leads new generations to endure the same conditions. The process is social mobilization - bringing people together on new terms for a common purpose. The conceptual tools are 'social guidance' (recruiting local men and women who will take on a leadership role), advocacy, capacity building and awareness rising. The programmatic tools are training, support to institutions, micro-credit, infrastructure development, natural resource management and 'productive linkages'.

Offices:

Offices are at district and taluka level in all following districts.

SRSO as an implementer Partner:

SRSO supported SRP's efforts to open NFE centers in district Kashmore and Jacobabad. Children ages of 10-16 years had been enrolled in NFE centers.

Non Formal Education

Non Formal Education is a project that has been started for those children who were denied to their basic right. SRSO–SS as an implementing partner submitted a proposal for non formal Education to SRP procurement department under the Sindh reading program. SRSO-SS was selected & awarded two districts for the NFE Activity of SRP Project under the USAID at Jacobabad and Kashmore districts. The purpose of this project is to achieve the goal education for all through enrolling children ages of 10-16 years in NFE centers. SRSO-SS supported the project and also identified the learners, hired teachers, and supervised NFE centers in Jacobabad and Kashmore districts of Sindh province.

SRSO-SS identified and enrolled learners for the NFE centers and hired teachers who were be trained in the use of SRP-provided NFE materials (textbooks and teacher guides) The NFE curriculum material is consist of a total of three books per student. Sindhi, English, Math. The NFE syllabus was covered as per shared scheme of study.

Resume NFE-Package-B

SRSO resumed NFE activities to complete Package B and retained maximum NFE learners and teachers. SRSO ceased work in March-17due to delay for vetting approval for SRSO, therefore Package-B classes were run only for 06 month. Now SRSO received approval and resume Package –B However, it was time consuming and complicated for SRSO to coordinate with the NFE teachers and parents of NFE learners to restart work in order to retain the maximum number of learners. SRSO continue NFE-package-B activities and retained 47 center and 1189 instead of 67 Centers& 1940 learners. SRSO Project staff took stiff initiatives and completed the project task and targets timely. The period of performance was allocated to SRSO from April 30, 2018 to June 30, 2018.

During projected time duration Field team worked hard and dialogued with community and parents. Field staff also conducted mobilization session along with VOs and COs and motivated the local masses and parents of learners and the influential's to play their vital role to send learners to NFE centers. A serious attempt had been made by the Academic Coordinators and re-established 47 NFE centers at the same locations

It was also ensured that the NFE project has implemented properly and effectively functioning at the village level with same pace.
