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About the Project

Integrated Emergency Health, Protection, and WASH Response for Vulnerable Flood-affected Communities in Sindh Province of Pakistan: A Story of Resilience

The Deluge and its Aftermath:

In July 2022, torrential monsoon rains brought devastating floods to Pakistan's Sindh province, displacing millions and leaving communities reeling. Khairpur and Mirpurkhas districts bore the brunt of the disaster, with families losing homes, livelihoods, and access to necessities. Amidst this wreckage, hope emerged in the form of the "Integrated Emergency Health, Protection, and WASH Response" project, a collaborative effort spearheaded by the Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO).

A Holistic Approach to Healing:

Funded by the German Federal Foreign Office (GFFO), ADH, and Malteser International (MI), the project recognized the multifaceted needs of flood-affected communities. It went beyond immediate relief, aiming to build long-term resilience

Health:

200 Mobile Free Medical Camps, with provision of medicines offering crucial healthcare to **44,350** individuals in remote areas. Also addressed with mental health and psychosocial support (MHPSS) reaching over **17,000** people.



WASH:

Under the project **250** hand pumps installed, rehabilitated **05** water reservoirs, constructed **20** Demo Latrines for CLTS approaches, empowering communities to manage their sanitation. Also distributed Hygiene and MHM kits.



Protection:

Raised awareness campaigns on protection issues reached over 15,600 individuals.



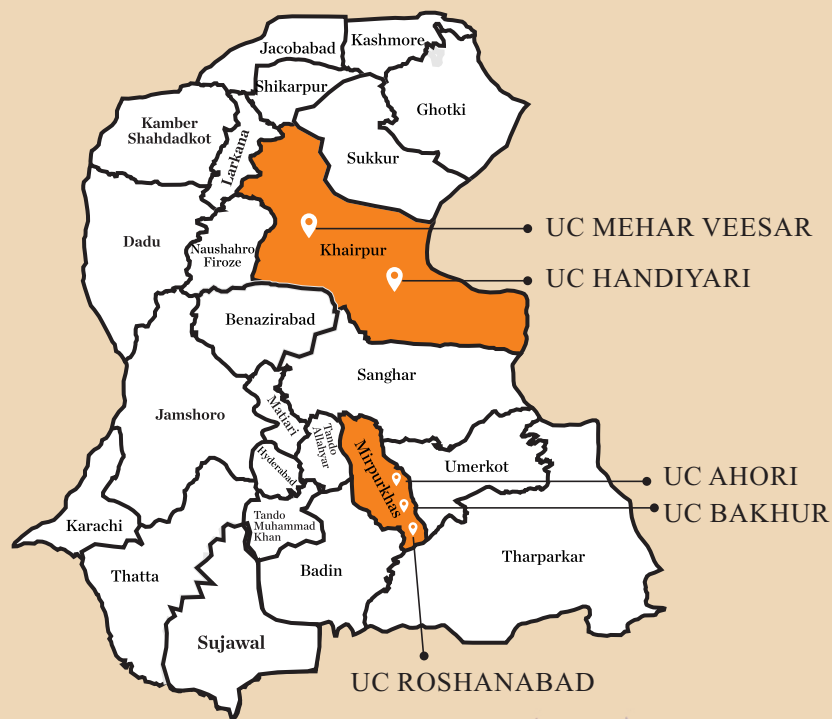
Nutrition:

Project Geographical Coverage Details



Key Achievements of the "Integrated Emergency Health, Protection, and WASH Response" Project:

Health



- Delivered healthcare services to **44,350** individuals through **200** mobile medical camps, exceeding the target of **40,000** individuals.
- Provided mental health and psychosocial support (MHPSS) services to over **17,191** people, addressing a crucial but often overlooked need.
- Distributed essential medicines and supplies, ensuring continued access to healthcare beyond the project's duration.

Water and Sanitation



- Installed **250** hand pumps and rehabilitated **5** water reservoirs, significantly improving access to clean water for communities.
- Constructed **20** community-led total sanitation (CLTS) approaches, empowering communities to manage their own sanitation and hygiene practices.
- Distributed **500** Bio Sand Nadi filters and jerry cans, providing households with safe and convenient water storage solutions.
- Distributed **1000** hygiene and **1000** menstrual kits to women and girls, addressing their specific needs and promoting dignity.

Nutrition



- Provided supplementary food to **300** malnourished children and **500** pregnant/lactating women, addressing a critical gap in food security.
- Distributed cash assistance to **600** persons with disabilities and **1,337** vulnerable households, providing immediate relief and supporting self-reliance.

Protection



- Conducted over **1,674** awareness sessions on protection issues, reaching over **15,600** individuals and fostering a culture of safety.
- Distributed Assistive Devices: **300** Wheel Chairs, **250** Audio Inductions Devices, **250** Walking Frame and **250** Walking Stick.
- Organized **16** street theater performances on protection issues, attended by **4,067** people, raising awareness in an engaging and accessible manner.
- Established a robust feedback mechanism, empowering communities to voice their concerns and contribute to project improvement.

Additional Achievements

- Exceeded targets in many areas, demonstrating efficient project management and resource allocation.
- Adopted a gender-inclusive and community-driven approach, ensuring equitable participation and sustainable outcomes.
- Actively involved Local Support Organizations (LSOs) in project implementation, fostering local ownership and capacity building.
- Maintained transparency and accountability through regular monitoring and reporting.
- Tree Plantation of above **3000** different Fruit, Shadow, and Forest Trees in villages

SUCCESS Story-01: Mukesh: Resilience After the Flood

The first critical step was the identification of Shuaib's alarming MUAC measurement of 11.00 cm. This prompted an immediate referral to BHU Hindyari, where he underwent a thorough assessment. Recognizing the severity of his condition, the healthcare professionals at BHU swiftly initiated Shuaib's enrollment in the Outpatient Therapeutic Program (OTP).

Through OTP, Shuaib received a six-dose course of highly nutritious food supplements. These supplements were carefully designed to address his specific dietary needs, ensuring he received the vital nutrients necessary for recovery and growth. Each dose was meticulously administered, closely monitored, and accompanied by essential health education provided by skilled professionals.

The impact of this intervention was profound. Shuaib's progress was not only visible in the improvement of his MUAC measurement to a healthy 12.00 cm but also in his overall demeanor. His energy levels increased, and he exhibited signs of better health and well-being.

This success story is a testament to the efficacy of timely and targeted interventions, especially in the aftermath of natural disasters. The collaborative efforts of GFFO, ADH, the nutrition assistant, and the healthcare professionals at BHU Hindyari exemplify the transformative power of community-based healthcare initiatives.

Moving forward, continued monitoring and support will be essential in sustaining Shuaib's progress. The impact of this intervention extends beyond Shuaib himself; it resonates as a beacon of hope for communities facing similar challenges. It highlights the potential for positive outcomes when dedicated individuals and organizations work hand in hand to restore health and vitality to those in need.



SUCCESS Story-06: From Desolation to Determination: Karma's Inspiring Journey towards Health and Hygiene



Rising from the Depths: Karema's triumph from adversity to empowerment of knowledge based attitude practices. In the wake of the devastating 2022 flood, Ramzan Lashari, a village in UC Roshanabad, found itself grappling with despair. This is the story of Karema, a beacon of hope who emerged from the darkest of days to become a symbol of transformation. The Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) partnered with Malteser International, financially supported by the German Federal Foreign Office (GFFO), to breathe life back into the community in this hardship time.

Karema, a woman of extraordinary resilience, stood at the forefront of change. The SRSO project team every week along with the SRSO team and Community Resource persons conducts the behavioral change session on Health and Hygiene, Behavioral change practices in the Vos meeting, and trickle-down session. With each session organized by SRSO, she absorbed not just knowledge, but a sense of purpose. She understood that hygiene was not just a practice, but a shield guarding her family's health. This realization became her guiding light.

In her home, Karema's voice resonated like a hymn of care. She spoke of handwashing, not as a chore, but as a ritual of protection. Before meals, using the facilities, and touching the world - soap and water became the guardians of her family's well-being. In this simple act, she wove a tapestry of love and safety.

Yet, Karema's mission was never insular. It spread like wildfire, touching every corner of RamzanLashari. Her words were not just instructions, but an anthem of empowerment. She didn't just teach cleanliness; she taught self-worth, dignity, and the profound impact of taking charge of one's health.

As weeks turned into months, the transformation was nothing short of miraculous. RamzanLashari shed its skin of desolation. Disorder made way for order, and the echoes of disease grew fainter. Karema's village, once shrouded in darkness, became a haven of light and hope.

From Shattered Walls to Healing Hands: A Community Restores its Lifeline

Village Organization leaders conducted a meeting while handing over the documents for ShifaKhaana Rehabilitation and the village said that Beneath the dusty plains, amidst a community scarred by floodwaters, stood a desolate sight - the Sindh ShifaKhaana, a once-vibrant health facility, lay crippled. Walls groaned under the weight of neglect, windows gaped like empty eyes, and the silence within mirrored the despair outside. Yet, within the ruins, a flicker of hope remained - the unwavering spirit of the community and the dedication of its health workers.

Beneath the arid plains, within a community scarred by the relentless deluge, stood a poignant sight - the Sindh ShifaKhaana, a once-vital health sanctuary, now lay in ruins. Walls sagged with the weight of neglect, windows stared blankly, and the silence within mirrored the desolation outside. The flood, beyond wreaking havoc on infrastructure, severed the community's healthcare lifeline. Skin ailments festered, fevers went unabated, and coughs echoed unanswered. Yet, undeterred by despair, the community rallied together. Their voices, amplified through the

Vulnerability Assessment and Social Mapping (VAM), reached the corridors of the Government of Sindh's Health Department, sparking a glimmer of hope.

With the Project's blessing funded by the German Federal Foreign Office, the journey of rehabilitation commenced. Crumbled walls were resurrected, and repaired windows allowed sunlight to grace the renewed interior. Gardens flourished where despair once lingered, symbolizing the resilience of the community.

The restoration extended beyond bricks and mortar this rehabilitation has rekindled the Shifakhaana. SUCCESS Story-52: Converting Safe Spaces into Learning and Earning Spaces - To Make Resilient Sindh Flood 2022 Affected Women and Girls



SRSO is serving flood 2022 affected women and girls through the establishment of Safe Spaces to overcome their trauma and stress, and tackle protection and violence challenges and issues by acquiring know-how about pro-women laws, referral pathways, and confidence to avail the services.

During the Sindh Flood 2022, an estimated number of 7,000 women were left vulnerable to neglect, abuse, and violence. Women who lost their belongings in the disaster did not have national identity cards that would allow them access to compensation in districts Khairpur and Mirpurkhas Sindh.

A safe space is a place where diverse women and girls feel physically and emotionally safe, free of violence, the fear of violence and abuse. It is somewhere they can feel free to express themselves without fear of judgment or harm and is a place where they can work together in solidarity, to mobilize and find their voices and space/fora to raise them.

WGSS is a vital entry point for diverse women and girls to report protection concerns, voice their needs, and receive physical and emotional safety. They provide access to multi-sectoral GBV response services and psychosocial support. They offer opportunities for diverse women and girls to rebuild social networks for mutual support and collective action in their community and engage in targeted knowledge and skill building.

Women and Girls Safe Spaces are a key strategy for the protection and empowerment of diverse women and girls affected by humanitarian crises. Women and girls around the world are disproportionately affected by crises. The prevalence and risks of gender-based violence (GBV) increase in times of emergency. Providing safe spaces for the diverse women and girls affected by emergencies is the most widely implemented GBV prevention and response intervention in humanitarian contexts. These spaces are established to promote

healing, well-being, protection, and empowerment opportunities. SRSO under the project named: has established the Women & Girls Free spaces at the Village Organization level
